WHAT MAKES FAIRTRADE UNIQUE?




When you see the FAIRTRADE Mark on a product it means that supply chains are independently audited to ensure the farmers and workers received the full impact of the Fairtrade Standards – not just a fair price, but safe working conditions, gender equality, environmental protections and much more. We're incredibly proud to be working in partnership with producers to change their lives. Fairtrade gives Canadians the chance to shop their values and make choices that support sustainable trade for all.

THE FAIRTRADE STANDARDS SUPPORT

PRICE PEOPLE PLANET

The Fairtrade Standards establish a holistic blend of social, economic, and environmental criteria for farmers, workers, traders, and other stakeholders to participate in this unique approach to trade.

PRICE FAIRTRADE IS ABOUT RETTER PRICES



Fairtrade is the only independent third party certification that has a <u>Minimum Price</u> for most products to ensure farmers and workers have sustainable livelihoods.

This acts as a safety net for the times when pressure from unfair trading conditions drives the market price lower than the cost of production.

Producers also receive the <u>Fairtrade</u> <u>Premium</u>, an additional sum that they invest as they choose in order to develop their communities or businesses.

PEOPLE

WITH FAIRTRADE, PRODUCERS HAVE MORE POWER.





<u>Producers own 50%</u> of the Fairtrade system, meaning that all decision making is equally shared.

In addition, the Fairtrade Standards ensure safe working conditions, gender equity, and prohibit child & forced labour.



Climate change is affecting the livelihoods of millions of producers in the Global South. Their incomes have already fallen due to extreme weather conditions, pests, and plant diseases brought about by climate change.

Fairtrade is helping producers adapt to this changing climate, and mitigate other major environmental problems, like biodiversity loss, soil degradation, the use of harmful chemicals, and excessive water consumption.





Our month-long celebration of all things Fairtrade – look for activities across Canada such as retail samples and specials, community happenings, and other events.


World Fair Trade Day
