

97-01 XJ Center Console Mount Installation Instructions

Thank you for purchasing our 97-01 XJ Center Console Mount!

Installation Notes:

- Refer to your factory service manual to remove any factory components.
- This is intended to replace the broken Center Console Mount in a Jeep Cherokee from 1997-2001.

Tools required:

• Philips head screwdriver.

Step1:

Park the Jeep on a level surface, chock the tires and disconnect the battery. This is done because the console will be easier to remove with the transfer case in the neutral position and the parking brake engaged.




Step2:

Remove the transmission shifter knob and both bezels by pulling them upward. Once removed the lights will also need to be unplugged from the bezel housings.



Step3:

Remove the 4 screws holding the center console in place. One can be found under each bezel and two in the storage compartment under the arm rest.




Step4:

Raise the center console and AC duct by lifting them up and out of the way. Be careful not to bind any components at this point because they can be brittle, easy to break and difficult to replace.



Step5:

Remove the 3 screws holding the broken factory center console mount and its pieces noting its orientation for the replacement.



Step6:

Install the new mount to the chassis with the 3 factory screws and clip nuts provided as shown. Install the rear most screw first loosely and then move forward. Tighten all 3 once they are started.



Step7:

Reinstall the AC duct, center console and bezel assemblies by reversing steps 4 through 1 and the installation is complete. Be sure to completely seat the AC duct in its connector near the dash.
