- These Molle Panels are designed to fit a 2020-Current Jeep Gladiator JT.
- Refer to your factory service manual when removing any factory components.
- The Molle Panels will work with the Mopar Trail Rail PN: 82215956 with slight modification.
- The Molle Panels will need to be painted or powder coted before installation we recommend you test fit the panels before painting.

- 3/8" Ratchet
- 1/4" Ratchet
- 4" Extension
- 4MM Allen Socket
- 7/32" Allen Socket
- 5/32" Allen Socket
- 7/16" Wrench
- Antiseize

Step 1:

If the Jeep is equipped with the Mopar Trail Rail remove the passenger side. If the Jeep is not equipped with the trail rail skip to step 3.


Step 2:

Drill the plastic tab on the trail rail out to a 3/8" hole as shown below.



Step 3:

Assemble the molle panels as shown below and tighten hardware.



Step 4:

Non-Trail Rail

Install the molle panel assembly on to the JT bed as shown below. Use the suppled m6 bolts to install the panel to the bed. The threads in the bed may need to be chased with a tap if they have never been used. The tap size is M6X1.

Trail Rail

Install the molle panel assembly and the trail rail at the same time. Reuse the factory hardware.



Step 5:

From underneath the bed, install the supplied channel nut. Install the 3/8" hardware through the panel bracket as shown below.

If the Jeep is equipped with the Mopar Trail Rail remove the front rail.


Step 2:

Assemble the molle panels as shown below and tighten hardware.




Step 4:

If the Jeep is equipped with the Mopar Trail Rail remove the driver side. If the Jeep is not equipped with the trail rail skip to step 3.


Step 2:
