

LJ Rocker Guards Installation Instructions

Thank you for purchasing our Jeep LJ Rocker Guards!

Installation Notes:

- All hardware is stainless steel to prevent corrosion. Hardware will need installed by hand with antiseize to prevent galling.
- This product is designed to fit a 2004-2006 Jeep Wrangler LJ
- Drilling into the body of your Jeep is required for installation.
- Refer to your factory service manual when removing any factory components
- Trimming of the factory fender flares may be required for installation

Tools required:

- Drill
- 3/8" Drill Bit
- 16MM Socket
- 8MM Socket
- 7/32" Allen Socket
- 9/16" Wrench
- 1/2" Ratchet
- 3/8" Ratchet
- Floor Jack
- Antiseize

Step 1:

Park the Jeep on a level surface and remove the front and rear fender flares on the passenger side.

Step 2:

Remove the three center body mount bolts

Step 3:

Place the floor jack under the body near the front of the door. Lift the body until there is enough room between the body bushings and the tub of the Jeep for the rocker to slide in between.

Step 4:


Slide the rocker guard in between the body bushing and the tub and let the jack down making sure the ends of the rocker guard are lined up with the body.

Step 5:

Reinstall the body bolts removed in step 2

Step 6:

Center mark the six holes along the top of the rocker guard. Drill these locations with a 3/8" drill bit. Making sure there is nothing on the inside of the tub that the drill bit may damage.



Step 7:

Install the supplied hardware through these six holes.

Step 8:

Reinstall the fender flairs on your jeep. Trimming of the flares may be required for reinstallation.

Step 9:

Repeat steps 1 threw 8 on the opposite side of the Jeep.
