## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4$ " unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## From Fabric A, cut:

sixteen 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty-four 2-1/2" x 20-1/2" strips
two 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" strips
two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips
two 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips
two 2-1/2" $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips
one 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" strip
one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip
one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip
two 2-1/2" squares
From Fabrics B-Y, cut the following lengths from the 2-1/2" wide strips:

Tip: Organize the cuts with sticky notes showing the fabric letter. This will help with quilt assembly.

From the Binding, cut:
seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

Step 1: Gather:

- two 2-1/2" Fabric Q squares
- one 2-1/2" Fabric $N$ square
- one 2-1/2" Fabric U square
- two 2-1/2" Fabric G squares
- one 2-1/2" Fabric D square
- one 2-1/2" Fabric M square
- one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G rectangle
- one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $M$ rectangle
- one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric O rectangle
- one 20-1/2" Fabric A strip

Arrange to form Row 1, as shown, paying close attention to the order of the fabrics in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew together, pressing the seams to the left.


Step 2: Continue this process, assembling Rows 2-35. Note the fabric placement and length of the Fabric A strips in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Press all seams in odd numbered rows to the left and seams in even numbered rows to the right.

Step 3: Sew Rows 1-35 together, nesting the seams and pressing the row seams to one side. Tip: Sew rows together in pairs, then sew pairs of rows together, continuing in this manner until you are sewing two large sections together to form the quilt.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!


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
