Is Human Growth Hormone good for you?

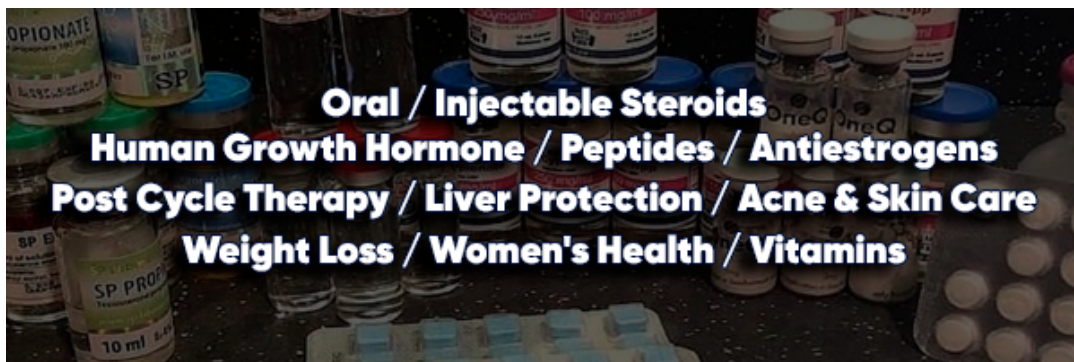
It's important for **growth, cell regeneration, and cell reproduction**. HGH helps to maintain, build, and repair healthy tissue in the brain and other organs. This hormone can help to speed up healing after an injury and repair muscle tissue after exercise. This helps to build muscle mass, boost metabolism, and burn fat.

Why is human growth hormone illegal?

The illicit distribution of hGH occurs as **the result of physicians illegally prescribing it for off-label uses** and for the treatment of FDA-approved medical conditions without examination and supervision.

What happens if you have too much human growth hormone?

When you have too much growth hormone, **your bones increase in size**. In childhood, this leads to increased height and is called gigantism. But in adulthood, a change in height doesn't occur. Instead, the increase in bone size is limited to the bones of your hands, feet and face, and is called acromegaly.

Can I take growth hormones at 17?

The Endocrine Society **do not recommend** HGH injections for adults or children unless they have a growth hormone deficiency.

Why do athletes take human growth hormone?

Also known as gonadotropin, HGH is a synthetic, or artificially-produced, drug that has an anabolic effect, meaning it promotes muscle-building. Because of these effects, athletes will use HGH to **improve their strength and endurance** in order to gain a competitive edge.

Does HGH damage your liver?

HGH prompts the liver and other organs to make IGF-1, which affects many tissues and organs in the body. Studies usually measure IGF-1 rather than growth hormone directly because IGF-1 levels remain more constant.

Is HGH safe for females?

-HGH helps to control and maintain cholesterol and blood sugar levels. HGH replacement therapy for women promotes a natural balance to your body. **The supplements are safe** and have a multitude of benefits.

Will HGH ever be legal?

This hormone cannot be sold legally in the U.S. without a doctor's prescription—meaning any HGH you see outside of a doctor's office is most likely counterfeit or illegal. These products may also be dangerous and contain additives and harmful ingredients that put your health at risk.

Is growth hormone safe for bodybuilding?

Why Use Human Growth Hormone for Bodybuilding? The one benefit to taking growth hormone that has the most scientific evidence is an **increase in lean muscle mass**, which means a decrease in body fat.

Does growth hormone make your nose bigger?

' And the answer is, once you're an adult, **growth hormone will give you a big nose**, but it won't make you any taller. " Nose and ears, which are made of cartilage, continue to grow throughout a person's life, although in most people this is hardly noticeable.

Why is my daughter growing so fast?

Children with precocious puberty experience early growth spurts because of **the abnormally early rise in sex hormone levels in their bodies**. Initially this causes these children to grow taller than other kids their age, but their skeletons mature more rapidly.

Does HGH make your jaw bigger?

Excess growth hormone causes side effects such as: Thickening of bones in the jaws, fingers and toes. The heavy jaw and large digits that result is referred to as **acromegaly**.
