



Routine Maintenance for Collectors

Routine maintenance that collectors can perform while out on the route to improve the player and location experience and reduce the number of service calls:

- 1. Tighten the screws on the motherboard.
 - a. This reduces noise from electrical feedback and interference.
 - b. Bring along a Phillips head screwdriver.
- 2. Check the time on the machine.
 - a. Having the machine set to the correct time makes it very easy to navigate the logs when there is a question about a ticket.
 - b. Many machines are configured to automatically reboot each night. Having the correct time set on the machine will prevent this reboot from happening inadvertently during business hours.
- 3. Check the paper level.
 - a. If the location has a key to the machine, then the collector could leave them a spare roll to replace themselves.
 - b. Otherwise, he could replace the roll while he's there to prevent a service call.
