PIGGY BANK


Make a piggy bank to store your pennies!

YOU WILL NEED

Balloon · papier-mâchè paste · newspapèr · pin · scissors · glue · egg carton • pink paint • paintbrush

STEPS

- 1. Cover the blown-up balloon in papier-mâchè paste. Paste three layers of newspaper strips onto the balloon. Make sure you leave a small hole around the balloon's knot.
- 2. After two days, the papier-mâchè should be set. Holding the knot, burst the balloon and pull the burst balloon out of the hole by the knot.
- 3. Cut out and glue on five portions of the egg carton, for the four legs and the snout. Cut two ear shapes from the lid of the carton and glue these on top of the pig's head.
- 4. When your shape is dry, paint it pink. Paint on some eyes and a nose.
- 5. Cut a coin-sized slit in the top of the pig. When you want to retrieve your money from your piggy bank, cut a small square from underneath to tip the money out.









TURTLE TIME

Make your own turtle friend!

YOU WILL NEED

Papier-mâchè paste · newspapers · balloon · paintbrush · pin · glue · cardboard · pens · paint

STEPS

- 1. Put some papier-mâchè over a balloon, leaving holes for the turtle's head, tail and four legs. Make sure the head and tail holes are big enough for your arm to fit through.
- 2. When the papier-mâchè is dry (it may take a couple of days), paint the shell and then pop the balloon.
- 3. Stick on four cardboard legs, and paint a pattern on your turtle's shell.
- 4. Draw eyes and a mouth on your fist. Then place your arm through the tail hole and out of the head hole, so that your fist become the turtle's head!
