At first glance, these errors may seem complicated. You may even think that you do not make any of these errors in your essays. Once you read the definition of each of these errors, you will understand that a large portion of your essay might contain these common sentence-structure errors.

The first error is called the dangling modifier. This error states that the writer has not identified what is being changed in the sentence. In simple terms, if the subject is missing from the sentence, then that is an example of a dangling modifier.

The second error is known as a squinting modifier. This usually happens when the writer splits up the sentence for no reason. This leads to confusion over what word is being modified.

The third error in sentence structure is called an illogical sentence. Another name for this error is a jumbled sentence. An illogical sentence is called illogical because the ordering of the clauses is wrong. This error can be easily fixed by changing the order of coordinating conjunction that links the sentence together. This <u>paper writing service</u> can fix these issues in no time!

The fourth common error is known as a fragmented sentence. Another name for this error is an incomplete sentence. This error is given this name because the sentence only has a subordinate clause. This error can be resolved by connecting the subordinate clause with the main clause.

A fused sentence or run-on sentence is the fifth common sentence structure error made by students. In this type of sentence, there is no connecting word that separates the clauses. This error makes it feel like the sentence never ends.

The sixth error is called inaccurate subordinating conjunction. In this error, the conjunction used to link the main clause and subordinate clause is not accurate. The seventh error is known as inaccurate coordinating conjunction. Just like error number six, this error has inaccurate conjunction and can be resolved by replacing the conjunction with a more accurate one.

The eighth sentence-structure error is known as inversion of subject-verb. This happens when the positioning of the verb and subject is not correct. This can be fixed by putting the subject and verb back in their correct place .
