## On Point Pattern for 2 Log Cabin Kits

Finished Size $54 \times 81$ "


Here is what you need:
2 of Matt's Hand-Cut Log Cabin Kits (24 Blocks)
$21 / 4$ yards background
5/8 yard binding
5 yards backing
Make 24 Log Cabin blocks according to the directions included in the kits.

## Background:

Cut 4 @ $101 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ WOF (width of fabric). Sub-cut to $15-101 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Cut 2 @ 15" WOF. Sub-cut to $4-15^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Cut each along BOTH diagonals to create 16 side- setting triangles.
Cut 1 @ $73 / 4$ " WOF. Sub-cut to $2-73 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Cut each along ONE diagonal to create 4 corner triangles.
Lay out the Log Cabin blocks, side setting triangles, and corner triangle as in the picture of the finished quilt. Stitch into rows and stitch rows together. Quilt, bind, and enjoy!
