## Christmas Tree Panel Quilt

Quilt Pattern for 23" Panel
Designed by Donna Jordan for Jordan Fabrics
Finished Size $46 \times 66$ "


Fabric requirements:
1 Panel - at least $23 \times 43$ "
29 Layer Cake 10" Squares OR 26 Jelly Roll Strips (You can use more prints for better variety) Main Accent (Pinecones on cream)- 1 1/8 yard
Secondary Accent (Red Berries) - $1 / 2$ yard
Binding - $5 / 8$ yard
Backing - $31 / 4$ yards

If you are using 10" Layer Cake Squares: Take 11 of the layer cake squares and cut each into $4-21 / 2 \mathrm{x}$ 6 " rectangles for the corner patchwork blocks. Take 18 of the layer cake squares and cut each into $1-2 \frac{1}{2}$ x 10", $2-21 / 2 \times 8$ ", and $1-21 / 2 \times 6$ " for the border patchwork blocks.
If you are using Jelly Roll Strips: Take 18 of the $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips and cut $1 @ 10$ ", $2 @ 8$, and $1 @ 6$ " from each. Take 8 of the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and cut 6@6" from each.

Secondary Accent Fabric: Cut 2 @ 1" WOF (width of fabric) and sub-cut $4-1 \times 7$ " and $4-1 \times 7 \frac{1}{2}$ " for corner patchwork blocks. Cut 10 @ 1" WOF for strip units and small border around the panel.

Main Accent Fabric: Cut 1 @ 7" WOF and sub-cut into 4-7" squares for corner patchwork units. Cut 1@7" WOF, cut 3@ 5" WOF, and cut 2@3" WOF for strip units.

Sewing instructions: Stitch a 1" secondary accent strip onto one long edge of each of the main accent fabric strips and press seam allowances toward the 1" strip.
Sub-cut each of the resulting strip units into $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ widths. Stitch the longest accent units onto the $6 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces. Stitch the medium length accent units onto the $8 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces. Stitch the shortest accent units onto the $10 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ roll pieces. Each unit will now measure $13^{\prime \prime}$.

Use the picture below to lay out 21 of the pieced units in a multi-colored arrangement to make a side border unit. Stitch together and press seam allowances all to one side. Repeat to make one more side border unit. The pieced border should measure $421 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


Use the picture below to lay out 11 of the pieced units in a multi-colored arrangement to make a top border unit. Stitch together and press seam allowances all to one side. Repeat to make one more border unit for the bottom of the quilt. The pieced border should measure $281 / 2$ ".


Corner patchwork units: Using the picture below as a guide, stitch a $1 \times 7$ " secondary accent piece to the left edge of the 7 " square main accent piece. Stitch a $1 \times 7 \frac{1}{2}$ " onto the top edge side. Stitch 4 of the $21 / 2 \times$ $6^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles side by side. Trim the patchwork down to $7 \frac{1}{2}$ ". Stitch onto the right side of the main/secondary accent unit. Stitch 7 of the $21 / 2 \times 6$ " rectangles side by side. Trim the patchwork down to 13 ". Stitch onto the top edge of the patchwork unit.


Using the picture of the finished quilt as a placement guide for the orientation of the corner blocks, stitch the corner blocks onto each side of the top and bottom patchwork borders.

Cut the panel down to $22 \times 42$ ". Stitch a 1" secondary accent around all 4 sides.
Stitch the side patchwork borders onto each side of the panel, then add the top and bottom borders.
Quilt, bind, and enjoy!
