

Courthouse Steps Placemats

Fabric and Cutting Requirements:

Fabric A 1@2 1/2" WOF. Sub-cut to 4-2 1/2" squares

Fabric B 2@2 1/2" WOF. Sub-cut to 8-6 1/2 x 2 1/2"

Fabric C 2@2 1/2" WOF. Sub-cut to 8-10 1/2 x 2 1/2"

Fabric D 4@2 1/2" WOF. Sub-cut to 8-14 1/2 x 2 1/2"

Fabric E 4@2 1/2" WOF. Sub-cut to 8-14 1/2 x 2 1/2"

Fabric F 1@2 1/2" WOF. Sub-cut to 8-2 1/2" squares

Fabric G 2@2 1/2" WOF. Sub-cut to 8-6 1/2 x 2 1/2"

Fabric H 2@2 1/2" WOF. Sub-cut to 8-10 1/2 x 2 1/2"

Backing 1 yard. Sub-cut into 4-18x20"

Batting - 4 pieces 16x20" each



Always use a 1/4" seam allowance press seam allowances away from the center.

Follow the diagram above to stitch the patchwork in this order:

Stitch an F piece onto both sides of an A piece.

Stitch B pieces onto the top and bottom.

Stitch G pieces onto both sides.

Stitch C pieces onto the top and bottom.

Stitch H pieces onto both sides.

Stitch D pieces on top and bottom.

Stitch E pieces onto both sides.

Place backing and top onto fleece with right sides together. Pin and stitch around the edges leaving about a 4" opening. Trim off any extra fleece and backing and trim off most of the seam allowance in the corners. Flip right side out through the opening. Machine or hand stitch opening closed. Use your hands to press the edges flat. Quilt as desired and steam press.

Repeat all steps to make 3 more placemats. Enjoy!
