French Door Panel Quilt

Quilt Pattern for 28" Panel Designed by Donna Jordan for Jordan Fabrics Finished Size 36x49"



Fabric requirements: 1 Panel – at least 28x42" 44 –5" Charm Squares or 4 Fat Quarters (use more for variety) Accent –3/8 yard Binding – ½ yard Backing – 1 ½ yards (not included) Panel: Trim your panel to 27 ½ x 41 ½"

Cut the panel into six sections as shown below.



Accent: Cut 9 strips 1" the width of the fabric. From 5 of the strips cut 9 – 1 x 13 7/8" pieces.

Stitch a 13 7/8" accent strip onto each side of the bottom right panel section. Stitch another 13 7/8" piece on the left side of the bottom left section. Stitch the left section onto the right section creating the bottom row. Press seam allowances toward the panel blocks.

Repeat the procedure to make the middle and the top rows.

Measure the width of the finished row and cut the remaining 4 accent strips to that size. Stitch a strip onto the top of the top row, the bottom of the bottom row, and between the rows. The result should measure $28 \frac{1}{2} \ge 41 \frac{1}{2}$ ".

Patchwork Border: Take each of the charm squares and cut 1 ³/₄", 1 ¹/₂" and 1 ³/₄" as shown below.



Stitch a contrast $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " piece between two matching $1 \frac{3}{4}$ " pieces. Press seams toward the center. The block now measures 5×4 ". Trim the block to 4×4 " square as shown below. Repeat to make 44 blocks.



Stitch 8 of the blocks together to make a row. Stitch onto the bottom edge of the panel unit. Repeat for the top. **Hint: lay out all the blocks around the entire panel unit before making the rows so you can balance the colors and make sure the blocks are turned correctly.**



Stitch 14 blocks together to make a row for one side of the panel and repeat for the other side.

Quilt, bind, and enjoy!
