

## Make Merry Panel Quilt

Finished Size 30 x 37"



Yardage requirements:

1 Make Merry Panel measuring about 23x43"

Binding 3/8 yard

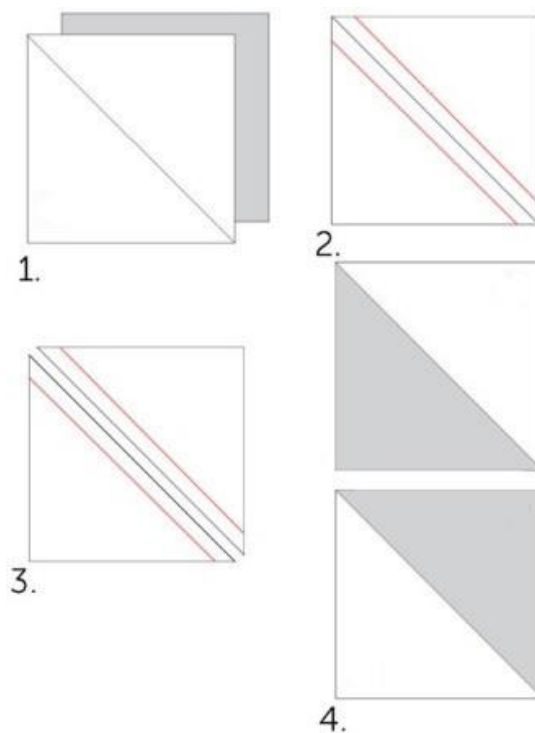
32 – 5" charm squares

Quilt backing required – 1 1/4 yards

Cut the Christmas tree panel to 23 x 30" (I left ¼" of the white showing on the top and bottom of the panel and cut off all the white on the sides of the panel)

### Half square triangles (HST):

Take a light 5" charm square and draw a diagonal line on the reverse side from corner to corner. Place the light fabric right sides together on a dark fabric square and sew ¼" away from each side of the drawn line. Cut along the drawn line to yield two half square triangles. Open the half square triangle unit and press seam allowance toward the darker fabric. Trim "dog ears" if desired. The finished square should now measure 4 5/8" square. Make 32 HST units.



### Quarter square triangles (QST)

Place one HST on top of another HST so that the seams nest. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the top HST going the opposite way of the stitched seam. Sew ¼" away from each side of the drawn line. Cut along the drawn line to yield two quarter square triangles (QST). Open the units and press seam allowance to one side. Trim "dog ears" if desired. The finished square should now measure 4 1/4" square.

Stitch 6 QSTs into a row. Stitch the row onto the top of the panel. Repeat for the bottom of the panel.

Stitch 10 QSTs into a row. Measure the length of your row– it should be about 37 ½” long. You may need to re-stitch some of the seams with a deeper than ¼” seam allowance to make the row fit onto the side of the panel. Stitch the row onto one side and repeat for the other side.

Quilt, bind, and enjoy!
