

## Jelly Roll Race Quilt

**Finished size 63 X 79"**

Quilt using "SHORELINE" from Moda Fabrics

**Required materials:**

1 Jelly Roll – 40 strips 2 ½" wide  
3 Accent Fabrics – ¼ yard each  
½ yard - inner border

1 1/8 outside border  
5/8 yard - binding  
5 yards backing

Step 1: Cut each accent fabric into 3 @ 2 ½" WOF. Take one strip of each accent fabric and stitch together along the long sides. Press the seams to one side. Repeat with remaining accent fabrics so that you have a total of 3 strip units. Sub cut strip units into a total of 40 @ 2 1/2" wide.



Step 2: Take one Jelly Roll strip and stitch an accent unit onto the short end of the strip. Finger press seams all to one side. Add another jelly roll strip to the accent unit, then another accent unit and continue alternating until you have used all your strips and accent units. You will now have one very long row ending with an accent unit.

Step 3: Starting at the end of the row that has the accent unit, measure 71" and cut (see chart for other size options). Your first row has the accent unit at the top of it (the 71" piece). Now cut a second row the same length. Pin row # 2 onto row # 1 and stitch from the top to the bottom of the row. Finger press the seam allowance to one side. It is very important not to stretch either the quilt or the strips as you sew!



**\*\*\*Note that in some cases your accent sections will line up, and not "stagger" enough. This depends on the size you are making, and the length of your jelly roll strips. If you see this happening in the first two or three rows, then cut off 2" at the top of each row and then measure and cut it to the length needed.**

Now we are off to the races! Repeat the process with row # 3 but stitch this row on from the bottom of quilt toward the top. Keep adding rows and alternating the direction that you are stitching so your quilt will lay flat. Continue until you have 24 rows stitched together.

Step 4: Iron your patchwork top very flat. Straighten the short ends of your quilt by using a rotary cutter and ruler.

Step 5: Borders

Inner Border: cut 7 @ 2" WOF.

Outer Border: cut 7 @ 4 ½" WOF. Stitch around all four sides.

Iron, quilt, bind and ENJOY!
