### Opponents Ships

### Battleship

Each player places 5 ships on the top grid, either horizontally or vertically. Use the following letters to represent each ship:

**Aircraft Carrier - AAAAA**

**Battleship - BBBB**

**Cruiser - CCC**

**Submarine - SSS**

**Destroyer - DD**

Directions: (print out a copy for each player)  
The players take turns calling out a spot on the grid using letter and number, such as A5. The other player says hit if they have a boat on that spot, or miss if they do not. Each player should keep track of their guess by writing either an H for a hit or an M for a miss on the grid labeled "Opponents Ships". They should also keep track of their opponents' guesses.

If a player guesses correctly for the all of the squares for a certain ship, that ship is considered sunk. When a player has a ship sunk they must report it by saying "You sunk my (aircraft carrier, Battleship, etc.). The first player that sinks all the ships of their opponent wins.

Salvo Variation:

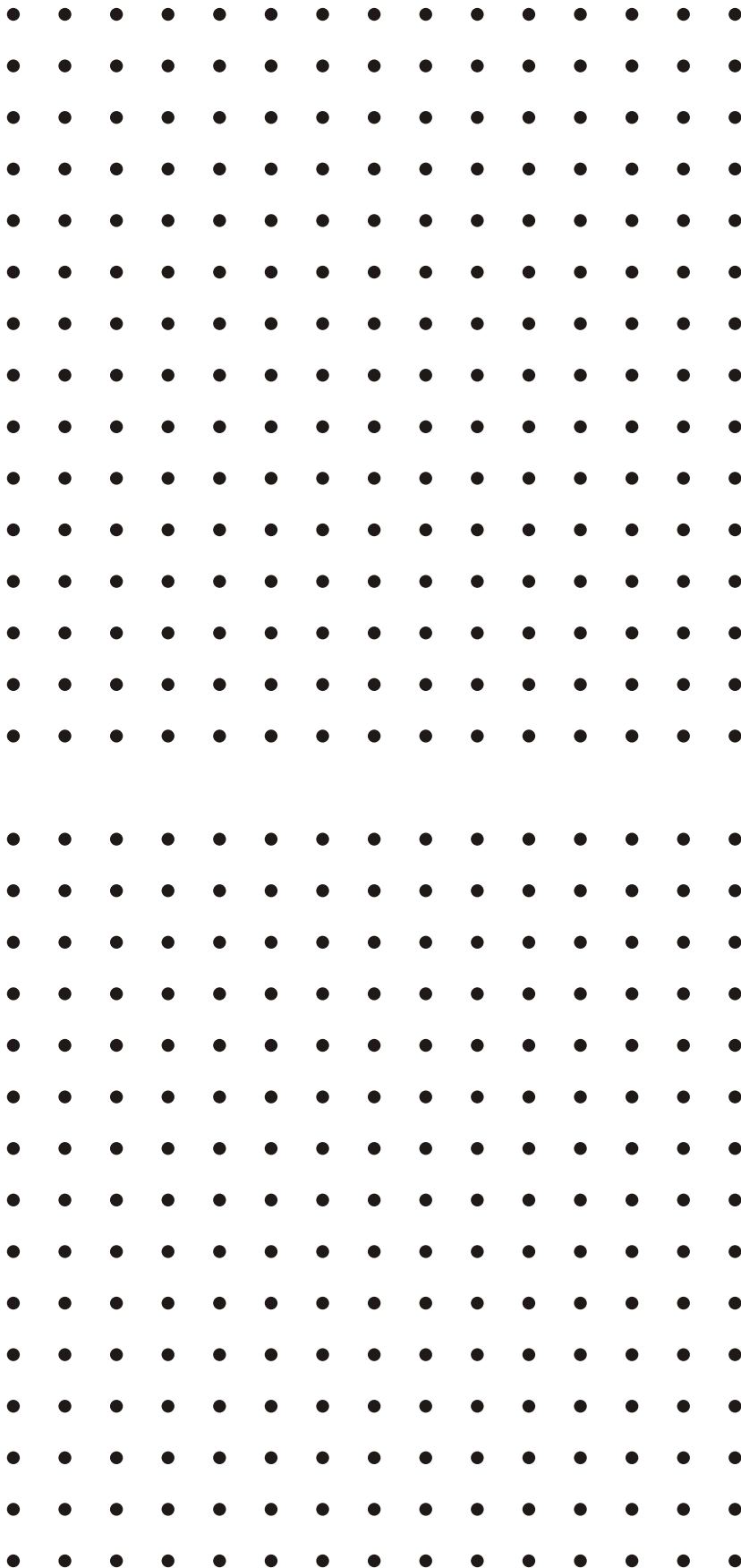
Instead of calling out one location per turn, a player calls out one location per number of ships they have. If you have all 5 ships, you call out 5 locations. As you lose ships you lose call outs (3 ships, 3 locations, etc.). Each player must first call out all locations (the opponent marks each location) before their opponent says hit or miss. The last one standing wins.

## Connect-the-Dots

Each player takes turns drawing a line to connect two dots, either horizontally or vertically. If a player makes the line that completes a box, that player puts their initial in the box. Once all the dots are connected, the player with the most boxes is the winner!

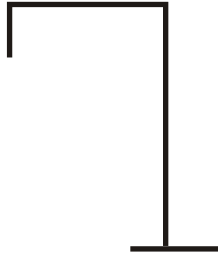
### Triangle Version:

To make the game last longer and more challenging, you can use the same concept as above except you try to make triangles.

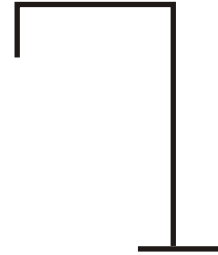

## Classic Car Games

**I Spy:** Probably one of the all time classic road trip games. One player looks around and chooses an object that everyone else must try and guess what it is. They start off by saying “I spy with my little eyes some-thing that begins with (use the first letter of the object’s name).” Or the clue can be the object’s color. The players take turns trying to guess what the object is. You will need some rules while traveling like - you can’t choose something that is whizzing by the car at highway speeds. Use landmarks (mountain range, forest, building, etc.) that will be in the players’ view for a few minutes. With kids it is a good idea to only let them have three turns in a row to prevent fights.

**20 Questions:** This is a classic and one of my favorite games. A player thinks of something, anything. The first question is always, “Animal, vegetable or mineral?” After that, the players take turns asking questions to try and guess what it is. “Is it bigger than a basketball?” or “Does it exist on this planet?”... with kids you never know! If you reach the 20th question without a winner, everyone gets one last guess to figure it out before the “thing” is revealed and another person starts a fresh round.

**License Plate Games:** There are several different games with all kind of variations. The ABC games starts out with the first person finding the letter A, the next person must then find B, and so on until you reach Z. You can take turns or play as a team. You can do numbers. You can look for doubles or triples. We use signs and billboards along the road also. Or you can try and build words or phrases using the letter sequence in the plates. A plate with the letter’s E, F and T, for example, might become the word “effort” (using those letters to start the word, in the middle and at the end). They could make “Ed’s Funny Toes” if your trying to make phrases. You can also use our template download to play License Plate Bingo.

**Slug-Bug:** The concept is that players keep track of how many Volkswagen Beetles they spot on the road. We always make them say “Slug Bug (color) - no punch back” (we don’t actually hit anymore because it can get out of control with kids) but it is still fun to listen to them get the color wrong, etc. Recommend you count them and the first one to 10 wins. If you see a Volkswagen Van it’s worth 2 points.

**The Picnic Game:** A memory game. Using the alphabet letters in order, the first player starts out by saying, “I went to a picnic and I brought an Apple”. The second player would say, “I went to a picnic and I brought an Apple and a Banana.” The next person follows suit and adds a C word. It gets harder and harder as the game goes along trying to remember everything at the picnic. Or try, “I visited the zoo and I saw “anteater”, and so on.

**Counting Game:** Simple, fun, and the little ones love this game. You can choose anything, telephone poles, cows, motorcycles, whatever. (My personal favorite is “flying” birds.) Sometimes it is good to put a limit like 25 or 10 to win... “flying” bird number 357 gets a little old!
