

DOG PROSTATE CANCER HEALED

Thought you might be interested in this case history.

Benson is a 14-year-old Long-Haired Dachshund desexed male dog.

Six years ago he was diagnosed with inoperable prostate cancer. He came to me for herbs and homeopathy and managed very well.
