

ABSCESSSES IN HORSE HOOF

A 10-year-old roan has abscesses in the hoof sole and wall on both sides. After 6 weeks of treatment with BIOPTRON, 3 times daily for 4 minutes per leg onto the hoof sole and 4 minutes onto the white line of the wall, the first success was evident. (All other medication was discontinued to more accurately determine the effectiveness of the Cold Light Therapy.)

Although the movement of the wall is still visible, it has been reduced by approximately 60%.

The degree of movement has improved. The horse is moving smoothly and feeding regularly on the paddock. After 3 months the treatment was stopped. This means that the therapy has a positive effect, however needs to be repeated according to the gravity of illness.
