I used purple, orange and Bioptron on Eric Rush (All Black, and captain of the All Black Sevens) for broken bones in his leg he got when playing rugby. He had a bone graft and the surgeon said he would be lucky if he was jogging in 4 months. By 6 weeks he was back on the bike and in the pool and had no pain the whole time.

In turn, he passed the set on to his grandfather whose foot was turning black from lack of circulation due to diabetes. He lived in the Far North, not near the hospital, and used the purple every day. His foot returned to normal. Eric's mother also used it to ease her asthma (orange on her lungs).
