Our daughter, Hineraukatauri, has severe cerebral palsy. She is unable to walk or talk, is tube fed by a machine directly into her stomach, has spasticity in all four limbs, suffers seizures, and has other very complex medical needs.

Throughout her eight years of life, Hineraukatauri has had many emergency admissions to Starship Children's Hospital to be treated for chest infections and pneumonia, particularly during the winter months.

Lee began Biopton light treatment with Hineraukatauri several months ago and we have seen a great improvement in her general wellbeing. So far this year, she has had no unexpected admissions to hospital, only routine outpatient clinics and surgical visits.
