RE: Zepter's Polarised light therapy

In the middle of August I had anterior cruciate ligament replacement operation on my right knee. As I only found out about Zepter's light therapy midway through September that is the time when my treatments have started.

I have been attending treatments daily for about 8 weeks. Each treatment took approximately half an hour. It is important to note that this therapy should be performed every day to achieve the best results.

At the beginning of the therapy my knee was still puffed up and swollen from the operation and I was experiencing some pain. After less than a week of attending Zepter light therapy treatments I have noticed a considerable decrease in the swelling and the absence of pain. As the therapy went on my knee gradually improved and I noticed a considerable improvement in the scarring tissue.

I found that Boiptron polarised light therapy had no side effects. In addition I was able to follow my physical rehabilitation in conjunction with the therapy.
