This outline of the event operations and safety requirements will apply for all SCF Sanctioned Level 1 and 2 events.

All approved events must comply with the following:

- ✓ Comply with UCI or SCF race rules and where all participants must have the required UCI International or SCF National-level racing licence
- ✓ Identify a secondary race route/course/venue as contingency
- ✓ Complete and adhere to the Event Operations and Safety Management Plan (adapt the template provided by SCF) including procurement of adequate public liability insurance cover
- ✓ Ensure that the Indemnity and Consent Form is explained to and signed by all participants (copy of the Form provided by SCF)
- ✓ Ensure in the indemnity and Consent Form that all participants confirm that they can ride a bicycle confidently and competently and complete a PAR-Q Form prior to the commencement of the event (Physical Activity Readiness Questionnaire)
- ✓ Comply with all traffic rules and regulations
- ✓ Ensure that certified first aiders and paramedics (and ambulances) are on standby, on-site
- ✓ Provide an incident report within 24 hours, should there be an occurrence of an incident (copy of the Form provided by SCF)

NOTE: An event may be cancelled, postponed or moved to a secondary location due to extreme weather conditions or when the minimum technical and / or safety requirements are deemed not to have been fulfilled.
