

And the dishwasher can only be used to wash household utensils.

The dishwasher will be damaged or the user will be injured when the operation is wrong.



Linärie does not assume any liability for damage arising from non-adherence to these documents and from improper assembly. The electricity connection must be made by a qualified specialist. Installation must comply with the valid standards, regulations and laws. All safety and warning information and the operating and installation instructions must be complied with.

#### 1. GENERAL INFORMATION

- A damaged appliance can be dangerous. If you find the appliance is damaged or marked, you must report it within 7 days if you wish to claim for damage/marks under the manufacturer's warranty. This does not affect your statutory rights. Do not use a damaged appliance.
- The manufacturer's warranty will be invalidated if the appliance is not repaired by a Linärie approved service technician.
- Faulty components must only be replaced by genuine Linärie spare parts. The manufacturer can only
  guarantee the safety of the appliance when Linärie replacement parts are used.
- If the power cord is damaged, it must only be replaced by a Linärie authorized service technician or suitably qualified electrician in order to avoid a hazard.
- Linärie cannot be held liable for noncompliance with these instructions, resulting from incorrect or improper use or operation.

The appliance complies with the stipulated safety requirements in Australia. The user is responsible for appliance cleaning and maintenance as well as its safe use. Improper use can lead to personal injury and damage to property.



#### WARNING

This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

#### Children and People with Special Needs

- The appliance is NOT suitable for use by children without supervision.
- Young children should be supervised near the appliance to ensure they do not play with this appliance.
- Children may be able to wrap themselves in packing material or pull it over their heads with the risk of suffocation. Keep children away from any packing material.

#### **Unauthorized Modifications**

Unauthorised modifications can cause the appliance to pose risks. Do not conduct any modifications
to the appliance.

#### 2.1 Safety Instructions - Installation



The appliance must only be installed and assembled by trained specialists who are familiar with and comply with the standard national regulations and supplementary regulations.

- In order to avoid any potential hazard, the installation instructions must be followed.
- Observe all regional regulations for the installation.
- Do not connect the appliance to the mains electricity supply by a multi-socket unit or an extension lead.
- Tampering with electrical connections or components and mechanical parts is highly dangerous to the
  user and can cause operational faults. Under no circumstances should any other parts of the housing
  be opened.
- The power source of dishwasher has to adopt earth line for safety.
- After installation, please make sure the connection of water and power is well connected before using.
- The installation position of drainage pipe should not exceed 40cm or higher than the top of the
  appliance, which will cause poor drainage, electrical shortcircuits and water leakage.
- This dishwasher is an automatic appliance, DO NOT add water manually when the appliance is working.
- Do not open the door during operation as the steam can cause serious injury.
- If it is necessary to load or unload some utensils, please use the pause button and wait for 10 seconds, then open the door slightly and wait for the steam to dissipate completely, then open the door and move your utensils.
- Be careful when cutting up the cable ties, sharp scissor might burst the pipe and cord.
- The appliance is to be connected to the water mains using a new hose sets.
- Do not use an old hose sets.
- · During installation, the power supply must not be excessively or dangerously bent or flattened.
- Please use flat scissors to cut the cable tie of water pipes and power lines when unpacking boxes.
- Position the appliance in the desired location. Confirm that the machine has been leveled.
- Please don't put anything else on either side, The openings must not be obstructed by a carpet.
- Please use cold water or warm water not exceeding 49°C.
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly
  qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- The door is not left in the open position since this could present a tripping hazard.
- WARNING: Some dishwasher detergents are strongly alkaline. They can be extremely dangerous if swallowed. Avoid contact with the skin and eyes and keep children away from the dishwasher when the door is open. Check that the detergent receptacle is empty after completion of the wash cycle.

#### 2.2 Safety Instructions - Operation

- Knives and other utensils with sharp points must be loaded in the basket with their points down or placed in a horizontal position.
- Do not move or clean appliance when it is working. It might cause electrical shock or water leakage.
- Please use specialized detergents. Do not use washing-up liquid, washing powder, hand sensitizer soup or others detergents that is not specialized for dishwasher.
- Do not try to use this appliance in damp place. High humidity will make the appliance rusty, or leak.
- Place specialized detergent on a place where kids can not reach. Detergents are contains acidoid
  and alkaline, which are really dangerous.
- Utensils will be hot after washing, please take it out after 30 minutes.
- Please keep the appliance at room temperature for 8 hours after receiving the product in winter, to avoid the droplets appearing on the surface of the glass, and it can damage the appliance.
- Always close the door when not in use.
- Always cut off the power and water after using.



#### WARNING

Knives and other utensils with sharp points must be loaded in the basket with their points down or placed in a horizontal position.



#### WARNING

When using your dishwasher, follow basic precautions, including the following:

- Read all instructions before using the dishwasher.
- Use the dishwasher only for its intended function.
- Use only detergents or wetting agents recommended for use in a dishwasher and keep them out
  of the reach of children.
- When loading items to be washed:
  - Locate sharp items so that they are not likely to damage the door seal;
  - Load sharp knives with the handles up to reduce the risk of cut-type injuries.
- Do not wash plastic items unless they are marked "dishwasher safe" or the equivalent.
   For plastic items not so marked, check the manufacturer's recommendations.
- Do not touch the heating element during or immediately after use.
- Do not operate your dishwasher unless all enclosure panels are properly in place.
- Do not tamper with controls.
- Do not abuse, sit on, or stand on the door or dish rack of the dishwasher.
- HYDROGEN GAS IS EXPLOSIVE. Under certain conditions, hydrogen gas might be produced in a
  hot-water system that has not been used for two weeks or more. Before using the dishwasher
  turn on all hot-water faucets and let the water flow from each for several minutes. This will release
  any accumulated hydrogen gas. Do not smoke or use an open flame during this time.
- Remove the door of the washing compartment when removing an old dishwasher from service or discarding it.

#### 2.3 Cleaning & Maintenance


- The device must be cleaned regularly. Dirt can lead to damage or the buildup of odors. (See "Cleaning and maintenance" section).
- Always clean the appliance exactly as indicated in the operating instructions.
- Always ensure the appliance is switched off before cleaning or replacing parts.
- Clean the appliance immediately after any food spillage and the filter regularly to keep the appliance working efficiently.
- There is a risk of fire if cleaning is not carried out as described in these operating instructions.
- Make sure no water penetrates inside the device when cleaning. Do not use any steam device to clean
  this appliance. The steam could reach electrical components and cause a short circuit.
- In areas which may be subject to infestation by cockroaches or other vermin, pay particular attention to keeping the machine and its surroundings in a clean condition at all times. Any damage which may be caused by cockroaches or other vermin will not be covered by the machine warranty.




#### Running water inlet


2 Insert one end of the pipe with the filter into the container. Suction cups should sucking on the inner of containers bottom.

The inlet pipe can not be recycled. Do not use an old inlet pipe in installation.



#### 1 Operate the Dishwasher



#### 2 Overview of programmes





The preserve button has the function of regular ventilation and storage, which can effectively remove odor, mild dew, moisture (etc). The "Dry" indicator on the display is on when you select it. The dishwasher will run this function after the washing program finished with fan ventilate every 3 hours for 18 minutes within 24 hours. Meanwhile the fan running, the Indicator will displays "FAN". Press the button when you need to cancel this function. The dishwasher will not start this function after the washing program is completed and the "Dry" indicator on the display is turned off.



It means Lock button. You can secure your appliance from being unintentionnally programmed. (e.g. improper operation by children). To activate the button lock: Hold down the button (a) for 3 seconds until "Lock" is indicated on the digital display. To deactivate the button lock: Hold down the button (b) for 3 seconds until the display "Lock" goes out.

#### 8. OVERVIEW OF PROGRAMMES

Special dishwasher detergent will remove oil and food residues. It is a must every time you use the appliance. Detergent dosage depends on the amount of and type of soiling.

The dry cycle starts automatically after each washing program, "FAN" is indicated on the display during the dry cycle to dry the inner cabinet, the energy consumption on this function is about 0.16kWh/cycle.




#### **IMPORTANT**

- Please don't put too much the detergent. Excessive detergent will not only produce a lot of bubbles, but also affect the cleaning effect.
- Please choose a suitable washing tablet, you should use the small one for this appliance.
   The actual runtime of each program is possibly different from the preset time cycle due to the water temperature, the amount of utensils, the type of soiling and the recovery of water softening.
   It is a normal condition, please use it with confidence.

#### 9. ADDING DETERGENT

Add the required amount of detergent after a pushed basket. Please put the detergent in the designated place.





#### 10. UTENSIL SELECTION







Glassware



Stainless steel tableware



- Precious metal, aluminum and colored glaze utensils may turn cloudy after being washed in a dishwasher.
- Cutlery made of bamboo or wood: It may come loose or crack at high temperatures.
- Plastics items: Please see manufacturer's instructions for plastics cutlery or items with plastics parts, because these items may come loose or crack at high temperature.
- Cleaning cloth: Cleaning cloth may cause your dishwasher faulty.
- Cast iron items: Cast iron items may rust after being washed in a dishwasher.

#### 11. TABLEWARE PLACEMENT ATTENTION

- Remove large food remnants such as bones or leaves.
- All utensils with dirt should be face down. Opening face or closing face down will leave the
  water on the top.
- Utensils are secured and cannot be tipped over, one place for one utensil.
- Do not let the utensils out of the basket to avoid obstruction of the spray arm's rotation.
- Small sized utensils might drop out from the basket and obstruct the spray arm's rotation, Please do not put these small items in the appliance.
- When pushing basket back, do not let the sharp parts of utensils get in touch with the seal.
- Avoid scratching top coat of basket, or it will be rusted.
- Always place unsorted cutlery with the tips face down, in the cutlery basket.


To check if the spray arm can still rotate, flip the spray arm after pushing the basket.


#### 13. MAINTENANCE and CLEANING

#### 13.1 Cleaning the filter assembly

After running the appliance for a while, there will be some residue and other things left in it. Please clean it when you see the residue and things immediately.



1 Make sure the power is off. Turn the filter assembly out counter - clockwise, then put the filter assembly back in, - clockwise.



2 Use flowing water to flush the filter assembly. Do not use steel wool or iron brush, it will cause the filter to rust.

#### 13.2 Cleaning the spray arms



Pull the main basket out of appliance, and lift the lower spray arm a little bit to loss the clips.



Turn the upper spray arm out counter clockwise. And put the upper spray arm back in - clockwise.



Check if the spray arms is blocked. If it does, please use a thin wire to pull the blockages out or flush the hole with water

#### 13.3 Cleaning the dishwasher interior

- Use a wet damp cloth to clean leaky seal.
- Clean the dead corner, Inside the dishwasher with citric acid and wet cloth.
- Please use specialized detergent to clean liner of dishwasher and inner pipeline.


