Zigzag Ringbolt Hitching Wrap

Materials

3 pieces of paracord

Object to wrap

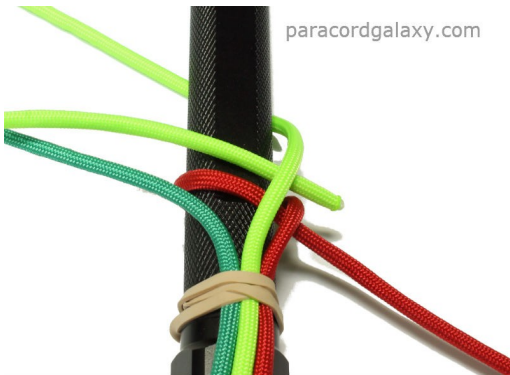

Step 1: Secure the three pieces of cord to your object with a rubber band and order the colors as desired.

Step 2: Bring the first cord on the right under the object going from right to left. Then bring it around and under itself.

Step 3: Bring the middle color to the right and under the object. Wrap it around then insert the end under itself.

Step 4: Wrap the third color the same as the previous two colors. Each should lay next to each other.

Step 5: Tighten each cord beginning with the bottom to the top cord.



Step 6: Cross the bottom color to the left and wrap it under the object then insert the end under itself.



Step 7: Repeat step 6 with the second and third colors. Tighten each as before.



Continue wrapping alternating to the right and left. Finish each end by binding the ends with a small string. Then cover the ends with a decorative knot such as the [Turk's Head knot](#).



The amount of cord needed will vary depending on the project. We used three pieces of cord at 2 ½ feet each and wrapped 3 ½ inches of a 1 inch diameter handle. *This does not include the finishing knots.
