How do I prepare my quilt for Longarming Services?

- Your quilt back must be one piece. You must assemble or sew your backing together and square it up for us to properly load it on the longarm machine. Make sure your backing is 10" wider and 10" longer than your quilt top. (For example, if your top is 60" x 60", your quilt back needs to be at least 70" x 70"). If your backing is not large enough, we will attach leaders and charge \$15.00 per leader. An extra fee will be charged if the backing needs to be pieced.
- Clip all loose threads from the back and front of the quilt top. Test it yourself. Lay a piece of batting under your top. If you can't see the threads, then your top is ready. If they're not trimmed, threads may show through light colored fabric after quilting.
- Please fold quilt top and backing separately.
- We will only longarm on batting purchased at The Sewing House.
- We will do our best to have the quilting completed by the requested date. Rush orders may be accepted at the shop's discretion for an extra \$50 fee.
- Just as soon as your masterpiece is ready, we'll call or email you!
- Minimum Quilting Fee is \$50.00.
- Minimum Thread Fee is \$6.99 plus tax.
- Longarm Services are \$0.03/sq.in. for edge to edge (E2E) designs.
