## Brodhead Christmas Bird Count December 15th, 2022

The 2022 Brodhead Christmas Bird Count (CBC) was the 18th year of this count. In 2022, counters found 50 bird species. The average number of species found is 50.2 5554 individual birds were reported. The average number of individuals is 5499. As these numbers indicate 2022 was a fairly average year for this count.

Eurasian Tree Sparrows were found for the first time on this CBC. One individual was reported in Juda and another was found at a feeder outside of Albany. Eurasian Tree Sparrow is the 99th species recorded in the history of the Brodhead CBC.

Only one species was found in record high numbers. The 23 Eurasian Collared Doves beat the previous high of 15.

No Rough-legged Hawks were found in 2022. This species had been reported in all 17 prior years.

Three other species were found for only the fourth year; Ring-billed Gull, Short-eared Owl, and Common Grackle.

Two Short-eared Owls found hunting a pasture along County FF.



23 Wilson's Snipe seen on Albany Lake. Rain and snow caused the water levels to rise. The high water levels meant the Killdeer seen at this location several days earlier were not found on the day of the count.



Eurasian Tree Sparrows have been found in increasing numbers in Green County the previous two years, so it was not surprising when two were found in 2022.



Several species were found in less than 50% of their normal abundance.

- Ring-necked Pheasant: 1 vs average of 10
- Wild Turkey: 64 vs 155 average
- European Starling: 765 vs 1717 average
- Red-breasted Nuthatch: 2 vs 4.9 average

Species reported at twice there average abundance were:

- Horned Lark: 332 vs 143 average
- Wilson's Snipe: 23 vs 7.8 average
- Eurasian Collared Dove: 23 vs 11 average
- Mourning Dove: 322 vs 162 average

The rain and snow the night prior to the count dampened our results. The wind kept some of the birds sheltered out of sight. Despite the weather we still had another successful CBC.
