

Pool Cover Care Guide

1. Regular Cleaning

Hose off dirt, leaves, and debris regularly to prevent staining and wear. Use a soft brush or sponge if needed - avoid abrasive cleaners.

2. Remove Chemical Residue

Once a month, remove the cover and give it a fresh water rinse to remove chlorine build-up. Let it dry fully before placing it back on the pool.

3. Avoid Sharp Edges

Keep the cover away from sharp coping, rough concrete, or pool fencing. Handle carefully when rolling or folding.

4. Use a Roller or Cover Bag

Always use a roller or storage bag to prevent folds, creases, and UV damage. Store in a shaded, dry area when not in use.

5. Let it Breathe

Every few weeks (especially in winter), take the cover off completely to give the pool and cover a break from chemical exposure.

6. Monitor for Wear & Tear

Inspect seams, edges, and bubbles or foam for signs of degradation. Contact Poolcare if you notice splitting, shrinking, or loss of flexibility.

7. Seasonal Tips

Summer: Use your cover daily to reduce evaporation and retain warmth.

Winter: Remove and store covers unless you're using a debris or automatic cover.
