


# Instructions for the Madison Forever Cot to Single bed (BC-MCFE)





# Stage 1:

Connect fixed side panel to the two end panels with the 4 X 70mm connecting bolts provided.(Do not tighten at this stage).



# Stage 2:

Connect mattress base to the two end panels with the 4 X 70mm connecting bolts provided.(Keep all bolts loose at this stage).


### Note:

The upper holes on the end panels are for the high base position. Screw 4 dropside glide pins into the end panels (Make sure they are tight).

# IMPORTANT

DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN GLIDE PINS

The skirt/flange of the drop side glide pins **MUST NOT** be beneatg the surface of the timber of the cot ends (see diagram).



# Stage 3

Push both end panels outward to allow space for assembly of dropside panel. Allow glide pins of one end panel into the runner first. Then allow the pins on the other into the runner by pulling both end panels inward. Ensure that correct side is facing out (see diagram)

Fully screw in the bolts on both end bars of dropside panel.


Tighten all the connecting bolts (Do not over tighten). Block remaining holes on the end panel with 4 X 28mm connecting bolts and 4 capping nuts provided.

## Note

To disassemble the cot just follow assembly instructions in reverse order.

**To lower the dropside panel** pull the dropside panel up to the top position. Hold it in that position while using your leg to push (at the centre of bottom bar) inward. Then allow the dropside panel to slide down.

To raise the dropside panel pull the dropside panel up (from centre of the top bar) until it clicks into the locking position.



# Converting to the Junior Bed:

Remove the drop side (see cot assembly instructions).


Remove the 4 drop side glide pins.

Reposition the base to the lower position (low hole of end panels).

Remove the fixed side.

Remove one end panel header.

Block the bottom whole with the 28mm connecting bolts and capping nuts provided.






# Converting to the Chaise Lounge:

Remove the drop side (see cot assembly instructions).


Remove the 4 drop side glide pins. Re-attach the fixed side.


If uncovered, cover remaining holes with 4 X F bolts & 4 X D capping nuts in end panels, the top holes whit 4 X B bolts & 4 X C capping nuts.




# Converting to the Single Bed:

a) Attach the base to the bed base rails with 4 x G bolts.





c) Insert 4 X Mattress Slats into base assembly.





# FOR AUSTRALIA AND NEW ZEALAND

(AS/NZS 2172:2003)

### RECOMMENDED MATTRESS SIZE 1320mm X 770mm X 120mm

This cot has been manufactured for use with a mattress which measures 770mm wide by 1320mm long and a maximum thickness of 120mm. The width and length are specified because it is important that the gaps between the mattress sides and ends of the cot will not exceed 40mm. This is to minimise the risk of a child's limb becoming caught in the gap. The thickness of the mattress has been specified to ensure that the depth of the cot is greater than 500mm with the mattress base in the lower position to minimise the risk of a child climbing or falling out of the cot.

# Warning:

- **\* TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF YOUR COT, REGULARLY CHECK ALL THE CONNECTING BOLTS AND GLIDE PINS MAKING SURE THEY ARE TIGHT.**
- imes TO Prevent falls or suffocation the maximum mattress thickness should not exceed 120mm .
- imes TO PREVENT FALLS, THE MATTRESS BASE OF THIS COT SHOULD BE ADJUSTED TO THE LOWEST POSITION BEFORE THE CHILD CAN SIT UP.
- \* Follow the manufacturer's assembly instructions in detail to ensure the safety features of the cot are not compromised.
- \* Ensure the cot is placed at a reasonable distance from curtains, blinds, heaters and power points.
- \* Keep cot free of any toys, cushions etc that could be used as a foothold or present a danger of suffocation or strangulation.
- \* Keep medication, String, elastic or small items such as money out of reach from any position in the cot.

# FOR THE UK

# RECOMMENDED MATTRESS SIZE 1320mm X 770mm x 120mm

If you leave the child unattended in the cot, always make sure that the drop side is in the highest position.

This cot has been manufactured for use with a mattress which measures 770mm wide by 1320mm long and a maximum thickness of 120mm. The width and length shall be such that the gap between the mattress and the sides and ends does not exceed 30mm. The thickness of the mattress has been specified to ensure that the depth of the cot is greater than 500mm with the mattress base in the lower position and 200mm with the mattress in the highest position to minimise the risk of a child climbing or falling out of the cot.

# Warning:

- \* TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF YOUR COT, REGULARLY CHECK ALL THE CONNECTING BOLTS AND GLIDE PINS MAKING SURE THEY ARE TIGHT, CARE SHOULD BE TAKEN THAT NO SCREWS ARE LOOSE BECAUSE A CHILD COULD TRAP PARTS OF THE BODY OR CLOTHING (EG. Strings, necklaces, ribbons for babies dummies), WHICH WOULD POSE A RISK OF STRANGULATION.
- \* TO PREVENT FALLS, THE MAXIMUM MATTRESS THICKNESS SHOULD NOT EXCEED 120MM.
- \* THE LOWEST POSITION IS THE SAFEST AND THAT THE BASE SHOULD ALWAYS BE USED IN THAT POSITION AS SOON AS THE BABY IS OLD ENOUGH TO SIT UP.
- \* TO PREVENT INJURY FROM FALLS THAT WHEN THE CHILD IS ABLE TO CLIMB OUT OF THE COT, THE COT SHALL NO LONGER BE USED FOR THAT CHILD.
- \* Be aware of the risk of open fire and other sources of strong heat, such as electric bar fires, gas fires, etc.in the near vicinity of the cot.
- \* Do not use the cot if any part is broken, torn or missing and use only spare parts approved by the manufacturer.
- \* Do not leave anything in the cot or place the cot close to another product, which could provide a foothold or present a danger of suffocation or strangulation, e.g. strings, blind/curtain cords, etc.
- \* Do not use more than one mattress in the cot.



# RECOMMENDED MATTRESS SIZE 52 in (1320mm) X $30\frac{1}{4}$ in (770mm) X $4\frac{3}{4}$ in (120mm)

This cot has been manufactured for use with a mattress which measures  $30\frac{1}{4}$  in (770mm) wide by 52 in(1320mm) long and a maximum thickness of  $4\frac{3}{4}$  in (120mm). The width and length are specified because it is important that the gaps between the mattress sides and ends of the cot will not exceed  $1\frac{1}{5}$  in (30mm). This is to minimise the risk of a child's limb becoming caught in the gap. The thickness of the mattress has been specified to ensure that the depth of the cot is greater than  $19\frac{3}{4}$  in (500mm) with the mattress base in the lower position to minimise the risk of a child climbing or falling out of the cot.

# <u> Warning:</u>

- The product, including side rails, must be fully erected prior to use.
- Strings can cause strangulation!! Never place items with a string around a child's neck such as hood strings or pacifier cords. Never suspend strings over product or attach strings to toys.
- Discontinue use of the product when child is able to climb out or reaches the height of 35 in.(890mm)
- When child is able to pull to standing position, set mattress/base to lowest adjustment position and remove bumper pads, large toys, and other objects that could serve as steps for climbing out.
- Never place product near a window where cords from blinds or drapes can strangle a child.
- Use ONLY mattress/pad provided by BOORI INTERNATIONAL (which must be at least  $30\frac{1}{4}$  in. long by 52 in. wide and not more than  $4\frac{3}{4}$  in. thick).
- Always provide the supervision necessary for the continued safety of your child. When used for playing, never leave child unattended.
- To reduce the risk of SIDS, pediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their back to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.
- Never use this product if there are any loose or missing fasteners, loose joints, broken parts, or torn mesh/fabric. Check before assembly and periodically during use. Contact BOORI INTERNATIONAL for replacement parts. Never substitute parts.
- Never leave child in product with side lowered. Be sure side is in raised and locked position whenever child is in product
- Never use plastic shipping bags or other plastic film as mattress covers not sold and intended for that purpose. They can cause suffocation.

Do not use this crib if the enclosed or attached instructions cannot be strictly adhered to. Do not use this crib if the child is able to climb out unaided or is taller than 90 cm. Do not place cords, straps or similar items that could become wound around the child's neck in or near this crib. Ensure that the sides are properly latched or locked in place when the crib is occupied. The mattress used with this crib should not be more than 15 cm thick and should be of such length and width that the gap between the mattress and the sides of the crib is not more than 3 cm when the mattress is pushed into the corner of the crib.

# Maintenance of your cot

- \* TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF YOUR COT, REGULARLY CHECK ALL THE CONNECTING BOLTS AND GLIDE PINS MAKING SURE THEY ARE TIGHT, CARE SHOULD BE TAKEN THAT NO SCREWS ARE LOOSE
- \* GLIDE PINS AND BOLTS SHOULD BE TIGHTENED EVERY FOUR TO SIX MONTHS TO ENSURE COT REMAINS STABLE
- \* TO CLEAN YOUR COT USE A SOFT CLOTH DAMPENED WITH WATER
- \* DO NOT USE STRONG HOUSEHOLD CLEANERS
- \* AVOID CONTACT WITH SHARP OBJECTS
- \* WHEN MOVING YOUR COT DO NOT DRAG, ALWAYS LIFT AND PLACE IN POSITION
