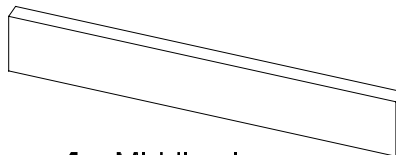
1 x Front piece



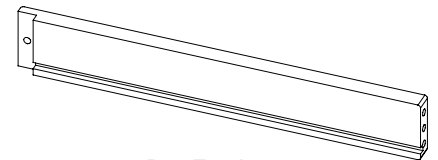
1 x Back piece



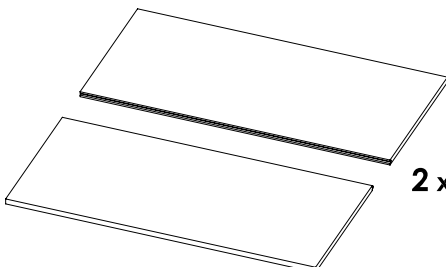

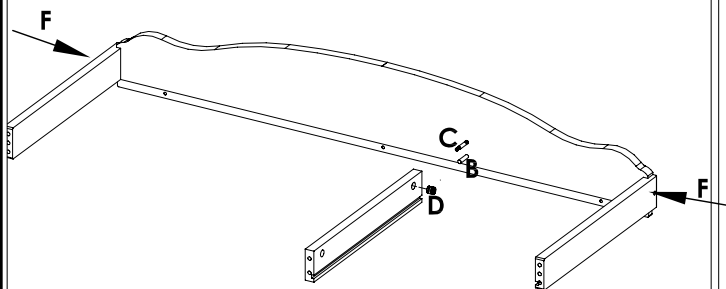


2 x Base board (Left & Right)

Assembling the Rosedale Changing Tray

Stage 1:

Attach left piece and right piece and middle piece to back piece with 2 x **F** bolts and 1 x **C** bolt and 1 x **B** wood dowels and 1 x **D** excenter fitting .

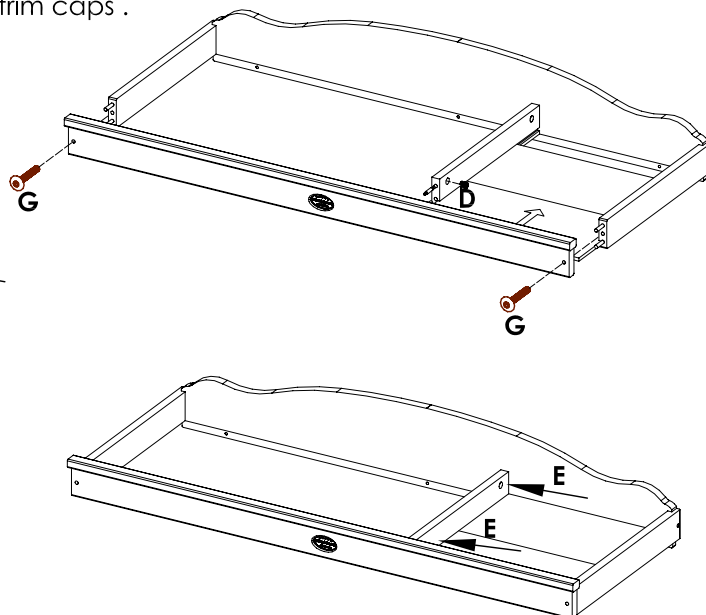


Stage 2:

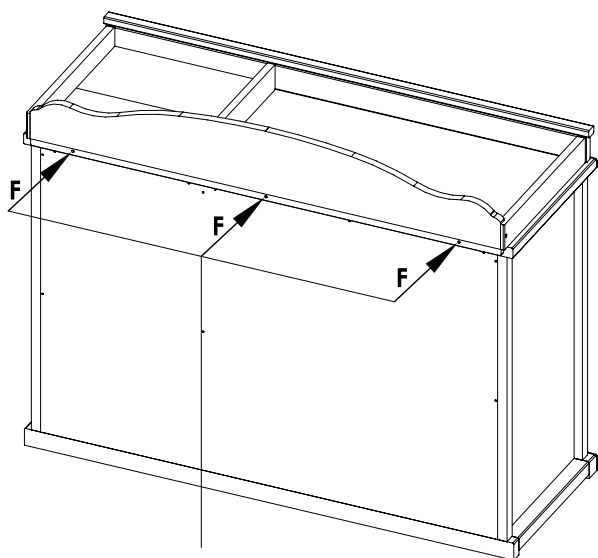
A) Slide base board into the grooves of right piece and middle piece

B) And then attach front piece with 2 x **G** bolts and 1 x **C** bolt and 5 x **B** wood dowels and 1 x **D** excenter fitting

C) Cover the excenter fitting in middle piece with 2 x **E** trim caps .



Stage 3:



Attach the Rosedale changing tray to the back of chest with 3 x **F** connecting bolts.



Maintenance of your Boori Country Furniture

- * TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF YOUR COT, BED OR CHANGE TABLE, REGULARLY CHECK ALL THE CONNECTING BOLTS AND GLIDE PINS MAKING SURE THEY ARE TIGHT, CARE SHOULD BE TAKEN THAT NO SCREWS ARE LOOSE
- * GLIDE PINS AND BOLTS SHOULD BE TIGHTENED EVERY FOUR TO SIX MONTHS TO ENSURE COT/FURNITURE REMAINS STABLE
- * TO CLEAN YOUR COT & FURNITURE USE A SOFT CLOTH DAMPENED WITH WATER
- * DO NOT USE STRONG HOUSEHOLD CLEANERS
- * AVOID CONTACT WITH SHARP OBJECTS
- * WHEN MOVING YOUR COT, BED OR FURNITURE DO NOT DRAG, ALWAYS LIFT AND PLACE IN POSITION
