

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I draw the inspiration from both textiles, architecture and furniture.


The main source of inspiration is always people, their relationships, interactions and life styles.




For me, design is about conceptualizing how rooms and things are experienced and used by people. I use form, aesthetics and materiality to convey activity, mood and tactility with the intention of making people want to use rooms and furniture again and again, and in different ways. Flexibility is a key word when designing rooms and furniture.

> Much of what I do is based on intuition and I think it is important to spend enough time to get a feel for the client, to find the meaning in the project. There are often no more than a couple of nice meetings where the talk comes in on everyday things, interests and humor. In addition, I do a survey to get a good insight into how the everyday life of the customers works and what kind of lifestyle they dream of. This part of the process is very important to me and is the biggest reason I started Alex Ark - I want to shape how I work.





> I like things to be modern, but still have a bit of history. When I start with an idea, I ´II work through boards of research and sketches. I search for something that can pull the idea into a new twist.





Tribute pays tribute to the design, art and architecture from the period of 1930 - 1970's, the Mid-Century movement, recognized world-wide for its functional and aesthetical significance for modern living. This was the epitome of Scandinavian design and the iconic designs from that period are some of the most coveted and easily recognized designs.

Tribute collection pays homage to the Midcentury movement in a contemporary ways and can easily be combined with the modern classics. Each design celebrates prominent figures of the movement and interprets historical references through the means of refined geometry, vivid optical experimentation and bold colors.

Pan

Pan, a series of three hand tufted designs by Jørgen Tycho (Oslotre) and the founder of Volver Ksenia Stanishevski, shows the intricate micro-structures of wood.





Jørgen Tycho is the founder and creative director of the Oslo- based architecture studio Oslotre.

Oslotre works with all aspects of wooden architectur e and is one of the pioneers of modern wooden structures in Norway. Jørgen works with the objective of connecting architecture and the urban closer to the biological and cyclical in nature. The work with Pan has been a process from forest to modern production. Carefully planned processes in which the topic is distilled and dissected. Quite alike how he works when drawing wooden buildings.

About Jørgen Tycho, architect and founder of Oslotre





Soul of a Tree

In their work with Pan collection, Jorgen Tycho, a wood architect, and a founder of Oslotre, and the founder of Volver Ksenia Stanishevski, searched to capture the soul of a tree.

The three patterns of Pan are extracted from a linden tree log from a Lime Linden Forest on Brønnøya in the Oslo fjord. The designers made precise cuts through the log at 3 different angles: radially, tangientially and travers. These sections show us the history of the tree though many years. Patterns from these sections are translated into rug patterns.

The name of the collection is Pan. In Ancient Greek mythology, *Pan is the god of forest and desire*. We are all nature; emotionally, physically and spiritually. Pan means " everything", and tells us about the importance of nature for our well-being.


This collaboration with Volver has lasted several years, and it has been a rewarding project of translation between two different mediums.

The Attraction rug collection consists of six hand woven rugs. A combination of mottled and clean colors creates the depth to resemble the layering of the monotypes. Abstract motifs are scattered over the patterned surface of the rug. Volver has put a special emphasis on expressing the artist signature through the rug medium.



Volver and the Norwegian multimedia artist Borgny Svalastog (b. 1945) have worked together for several years to transfer artists signature, temperament, and esthetics on woven rug medium. The result is a series of six expressive rugs, Attraction.

The designs translate Borgny's graphic works, monotypes, made on rice paper with several layers of transparent color. Her lines are expressive and personal. With swift lines she adds an array of elements on each layer. The motifs are often abstract, sometimes hinting at a subtle figuration. The elements are scattered over the paper in a way, which might at first seem accidental, but which nonetheless is marked by a precise intent. They often seem to mean something – almost as if they were letters in an unknown alphabet or a forgotten for of a musical notation.

Working with rugs is an intriguing area for me because it happens in the intersection between surface and object. From a distance, the rugs are seen as two-dimensional surfaces and it is the means of the drawing with colors, lines and composition that is most evident. The closer you get, the more three-dimensional they appear, and the means of the relief comes in to play; different materials, structures and height variations. At last, the tactile meeting - the different materials against the skin - soft, warm wool and silk-like

Rugs bring warmth to a room, and can function as both wall art, zone dividers, sound absorbers, and furniture. The fact that they are in-between -both when it comes to expression and usage - fascinates me.

Volver had only one requirement on the design brief. The project should be cross-cultural and relate to Norway.

The sacred topic of Yggdrasil and three norner was chosen as a theme. An ancient Norse legend tells about Yggdrasil, the Tree of the World, that reaches to the heavens and embraces the whole creation. It has three strong roots, that reaches into the underworld of immortality, where three norner water the tree from the Well of Fate. These three normer are sisters and between them they weave a treat of a human fate. Their names are Urd (Past), Verdande (Present) and Skuld (Future).



In their design discussions, Yorgo and Ksenia, challenged the limits of art, design and craft. The original sketches are intricate highly detailed abstract compositions inspired by the London graffities. They are organic, wild and dark. These qualities were translated and modified to create exquisite luxury rugs with richness of textures, elevations and colors.

The collection consist of 4 designs Yggdrasil, Urd, Verdande and Skuld. The rugs are handtufted with an excellent level of detail, equal to the craft applied in houte couture.

Yorgo Lykouria, creative principal and founder of Rainlight, brings over twenty years of experience across a variety of disciplines, from product design to aviation, automotive, to architecture, and filmmaking, winning numerous awards in the process. By connecting different fields of creative thinking, Lykouria uses its interdisciplinary toolkit that shows a unique perspective in many areas to this project.

Volver's vision is to enrich the Scandinavian design with the variety of personal artistic expressions. The studio aims to show the vibrancy, boldness and creative generosity of modern Norwegian design scene internationally.

Volver collaborates with Norway's best talents within design, architecture and art. The invited collaborators are given an open creative brief to express themselves freely and bring their personality, temper and visuals forward. In a dialogue and a co-creation process with the Art Director and founder Ksenia Stanishevski, these free ideas take shape into ready commercial products.

The designs address often themes beyond the ambitions of the interior textiles. Each collection is imbued with a special narrative, aesthetic and technical leitmotifs. Volver's work never develops into predictability. You would always keep on wondering what's next.

The inspiration springs forth from anywhere, handmade drawings, longing for the nature's untouched state, ideals of the past or beauty in the unconventional. The ideas infused into designs are charged with the artist's personal depth and challenge the notion of what we think an object, like a rug, actually is. Is a rug a canvas, fashion, art piece, décor, installation, fabric?

Each creative process is unique. It can start with a stone sculpture, an acrylic painting, hand free sketches, color palette or a piece of wood.

The exploration begins from an impulse and evolves through sketches, production drawings, material and colors sampling, choosing the right technical execution and finally a 1:1 final piece. These products are brought to the customer, to inspire, use and enjoy.

The creation of each rug is a collaborative process. At Volver our handmade rugs are the result of a shared expertise, passion and dedication of a diverse network of people.

One that ranges from the generational weavers in India to high performance young female technicians in China.

We put increasing emphasis on sustainability. All rugs are hand made only in natural materials, including also the backing and edging. Craing each rug takes several weeks, but each rug is highly durable and can last for decades. The techniques applied, range from flat weaves, the technique used by artisans for many hundreds of years to more modern hand managed techniques of hand tufting and hand-loom.

The technique or a combination of techniques is carefully chosen to fully manifest the original design idea in the best possible way.


Volver also experiments with modification and innovation in established craft traditions and is challenging to further develop and revive this rich cultural heritage. The in-depth knowledge of crafts, allows to deconstruct them and then construct them again in a new unexpected way.




























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
