# Sailboat Captains Materials:

large cardboard box, large wooden dowel, white cloth or paper, blue cloth, steering wheel prop, Bubble Wrap Sea creations from the Creativity Learning Lab, toy binoculars, hats, construction paper, markers, glue, scissors

### Prep:


Either beforehand or as a class, create a sailboat from the cardboard box and set up the dowel as the mast with the white cloth as the sail. Place the blue cloth on the floor as the ocean. Display the finished Bubble Wrap Sea creations. Position the steering wheel in the boat and arrange binoculars and hats for the crew.

### **Independent Play:**

- 1. Discuss various roles on a sailboat. Let the children choose roles such as captain, lookout, navigator, or deckhand.
- 2. Provide materials to make maps or flags, and suggest tasks such as navigating, spotting with binoculars, and managing the sail.
- 3. Start the imaginative voyage, with the captain at the wheel and the crew carrying out their roles.
- 4. Optional: Encourage the children to try the activity on the front of this card.

**Nurture:** Assist in role assignment to ensure understanding and participation.

**Enhance:** Facilitate a storytelling session post-voyage, prompting each child to recount their role's adventures and discoveries.
