Marshmallow Masterpieces

Materials:

large marshmallows, craft sticks or chopsticks, tempera paints, paper plates, construction paper (1 sheet for each child)

Prep:

Attach one marshmallow to the end of each craft stick or chopstick. Pour tempera paints onto paper plates.

Independent Play:

- 1. Show the children how to dip the marshmallow "brushes" into the paint on the plates.
- 2. Allow them to experiment with stamping and dragging the marshmallow on the construction paper to make different marks.
- 3. Invite them to explore mixing colors by using different paints with their marshmallows.
- 4. Encourage the children to share what they are creating and discuss the different textures and patterns they make.
- 5. Once finished, allow their artwork to dry for them to take home.

Nurture:

Have a variety of colors but limit the choices to three at a time.

Enhance:

Use the marshmallow painting activity to discuss textures comparing the marshmallow's softness to the hardness of sticks.
