

Notice to Insurance Company Child Restraint involved in an accident

All InfaSecure restraints are manufactured to Australian/New Zealand Standard AS/NZS 1754, which requires us to advise users of our child restraints to “Destroy the entire restraint if it has been in use in a severe crash, even if no damage is obvious”.

The Australian/New Zealand Standards Committee, advise that the above statement applies whether a child was in the child restraint or not. We consider a “severe crash” as being one where the main body structure is distorted.

There is no method of determining if the restraint has been damaged and we concur with the Australian/New Zealand Standards in recommending destruction of the child restraint.

This notice is to advise you of the requirements of the Australian/New Zealand Standards and our obligation in complying with the standards.

Please assist the owner of the restraint with their claim.
