ROLLER SEAR RELEASE ADJUSTMENT INSTRUCTIONS

LENGTH ADJUSTMENT

SOLID CONNECTOR

To adjust the length of your Scott™ Release with a solid connector, first remove the #4-40 socket head cap screw from the side of the release head. Then set the release head to the desired length and reinsert the screw in the corresponding hole on the release head to tighten. **DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN, AS IT MAY STRIP THE THREADS IN THE RELEASE HEAD.** This does not apply to the Scott™ Caliper.

CONNECTOR STRAP

To adjust the length of your Scott™ release with a nylon or rope connector strap, loosen the two #4-40 socket head cap screws that attach the lock down clamp to the triangular metal bracket sewn to the release strap. Slide the connector strap to the desired webbing length and retighten both screws.

TRIGGER SENSITIVITY ADJUSTMENT

The trigger tension adjustment set screw on your Scott™ Release is located at the base of the trigger near the trigger post. **TO INCREASE TENSION**, turn the screw clockwise. **TO DECREASE TENSION**, turn the screw counter clockwise. Test the release after each quarter turn increment. It is possible to adjust the set screw out too far [counter clockwise] **which will make the release premature fire.**

RECOMMENDATIONS OF USE

Your Scott™ Release is designed for string loop use. **DO NOT USE** any Scott™ Release in combination with any metal loop device. Doing so will damage your Scott™ Release.

RECOMMENDED MAINTENANCE

Your Scott™ release should be blown out with dry air after any use in damp environments. Once dry, it should be lightly lubricated with a light machine oil.
