Flower Origami, Make 10 Different Origami Flowers

Before starting to make each flower, cut the origami to each size and start folding.

What you need:

Folding symbols:

- Craft wire Mountain fold Valley fold
 Sellotape Inside reverse fold Outside reverse fold
- Scissors
- Glue
- Ruler & Nipper

SUNFLOWER *Small sunflowers can be made in the sizes listed in the brackets ()

- Flower...Yellow / 5 x 5 cm (4 x 4 cm) / 8 sheets
- Stem...Green / 15 x 4 cm (15 x 3 cm) / 1 sheet
- Flower head...Brown / 12 x 12 cm (10 x 10 cm) / 1 sheet
- Leaves...Green / 7.5 x 7.5 cm (6 x 6 cm) / 2 sheet (Instructions are on page 12 of Japanese booklet)

Flower

- 1. Fold across both diagonals and unfold
- 2. Fold one corner to the centre and unfold
- 3. Fold in half diagonally
- 4. Fold the edges along the crease from step 2
- 5. Unfold step 4
- 6. Inside reverse fold
- 7. Mountain fold one layer follow the crease from step 2 to wrap the flap from step 6, one module is complete
- 8. Make 7 more same modules
- 9. Apply glue to the corner, insert the corner into the side pocket of another module
- 10. Joint all the modules in the same way to form a wreath
- 11. \rightarrow Make Flower head & stem

Flower Head

- 1. Fold in half horizontally and vertically, then unfold
- 2. Fold the right and left edges to the centre line and unfold
- 3. Fold the top and bottom edges to the centre line and unfold
- 4. Fold the top edge slight down the middle crease
- 5. Fold the flat back along the existing crease
- 6. Fold the right edge cross the middle crease
- 7. Fold the edge back from the existing crease
- 8. Repeat 4-5
- 9. Repeat 6-7
- 10. Fold the rest in the same way
- 11. Flower centre is complete

Flower stem

- 1. Fold in half and unfold
- 2. Fold the right edge to the centre line
- 3. Continue to fold/roll the paper from right to the left
- 4. Flower stem is complete
- 12. Insert Flower centre into Flower, glue leaves type 1 *(instructions are on page 12 of Japanese booklet)* to stem and glue stem to the flower
- 13. Sunflower is complete

CHERRY BLOSSOM

- Petals...Pink / 3 x 6 cm / 5 sheets
- Leaf...Green / 7.5 x 7.5 cm / 1 sheet (Instructions are on page 12 of Japanese booklet)

Petals

- 1. Fold in half horizontally and unfold
- 2. Fold in half vertically and unfold
- 3. Fold the left edge to the centre line and unfold
- 4. Fold the tip of the left bottom corner to the fold line you made in step 3
- 5. Fold in half
- 6. Fold the bottom left corner to the cross point and unfold
- 7. Inside reverse fold
- 8. Mountain fold the top layer
- 9. Fold the top left corner to the cross point
- 10. Fold the bottom up behind
- 11. Fold bottom left corner up and unfold
- 12. Fold the same corner along the crease you made at step 11 and unfold
- 13. Fold the same corner along the crease you made at step 12 $% \left({\frac{1}{2}} \right) = \left({\frac{1}{2}} \right) \left({\frac{1}{2$
- 14. Continue to fold it up following the existing crease
- 15. Open from the top, one module is complete
- 16. Repeat and make 4 more same modules
- 17. Apply glue to the corner marked with a star and insert the corner into the pocket of another module
- 18. Joint all the modules in the same way
- 19. Spread the layers gently after the glue is dry
- 20. Glue the last remaining corner in the same way as step 17
- 21. Add leaves to the flower type 1 leaf *(instruction is on page 12 of Japanese booklet)* together and Cherry blossom is complete

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TULIP

- Flower...Red or Yellow / 7.5 x 7.5 cm / 1 sheet
- Leaf...Green / 15 x 7.5 cm / 1 sheet (Instructions are on page 12 of Japanese booklet)

Flower

- 1. Fold in half diagonally
- 2. Fold in half
- 3. Open top flap at the central vertical crease line and bring the bottom corner to the top corner (squash fold)
- 4. Squash fold is complete
- 5. Flip over, bring the flap to the other side and crease

- 6. Squash fold
- 7. Fold both corners in to meet at the centre line
- 8. Repeat behind
- 9. Bring together two flaps at the front and repeat at the back
- 10. Fold the bottom edges slightly up
- 11. Repeat behind
- 12. Reverse step 9
- 13. A little cut at the bottom
- 14. Open from the top and make it three-dimensional
- 15. Gently curl the corners

Leaf

- 1. Fold in half and unfold
- 2. Fold the corners along the crease line you made
- 3. Fold the top edges along the middle crease
- 4. Fold the bottom edges along the middle crease
- 5. Fold the bottom edges to the middle
- 6. Fold the bottom up at the \bigcirc point
- 7. Fold in half vertically
- 8. Pinch the corner, shift little bit and crease the bottom
- 9. Leaf is complete
- 16. Put the flower on the stem
- 17. Tulip is complete

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DAFFODIL

- Flower...White / 15 x 15 cm / 1 sheet
- Flower core...Lemon / 7.5 x 7.5 cm / 1 sheet
- Leaf...Green / 15 x 15 cm / 1 sheet (Instructions are on page 12 of Japanese booklet)

Flower

- 1. Fold across both diagonals and unfold
- 2. Fold each corner to the centre point
- 3. (Complete shape of step 2)
- 4. Flip over and fold in half diagonally
- 5. Fold in half
- 6. Open the top layer of the paper at the central vertical crease line and bring the flap's corner to the top corner (squash fold)
- 7. (Squash fold is complete)
- 8. Flip over and bring the top flap to the other side
- 9. Open the top layer of the paper at the central vertical crease line and bring the flap's corner to the top corner (squash fold)
- 10. Lightly fold in half the upper right edge and unfold
- 11. Fold the left corner along the fold line you made in step 10

- 12. Lift up and open the left flap and squash fold
- 13. Fold right edge along the centre line of the squash fold you made in step 12
- 14. Fold the right flap in the same way in step 12
- 15. Fold the top edges to squash the corners
- 16. Flip over and repeat step 10-15
- 17. Fold each flaps inward
- 18. Inside reverse fold the middle flaps
- 19. Make crease lines and bring them back
- 20. Close the front and back flaps and turn the sides (from step18) to the front
- 21. Inside reverse fold (repeat step 18)
- 22. Follow the creases to spread the flower petals to make them three-dimensional
- 23. Use nippers to round the ends of the wires and apply glue, insert the wire from the centre of the flower

Flower core

- 1-6. Fold in the same way as steps 1-6 to make a tulip
- 7. Paper at this step
- 8. Fold in half and unfold
- 9. Bring the right corner to meet the crease from step 8 and fold
- 10. Fold the left edge along the edge of the flap
- 11. Repeat step 8-10 on the other side
- 12. Evenly separate 4 flaps
- 13.Apply a little glue to the place shown in the diagram
- 24. Insert the core of the flower into flower and glue it
- 25. Insert the craft wire into the gap of a leaf type 4 *(instructions are on page 12 of Japanese booklet)* and glue them together
- 26. Daffodil is complete

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MARGUERITE DAISY

- Flower petals...White / 7.5 x 7.5 cm / 4 sheets
- Flower core...Lemon / 4 x 4 cm / 1 sheet
- Flower calyx...Green / 4 x 4 cm / 1 sheet
- Leaves...Green / 5 x 5 cm / 2 sheets (Instructions are on page 12 of Japanese booklet)

Flower petals

- 1. Fold in half horizontally and unfold
- 2. Fold the top left corner down to meet the middle line (the fold starts at the bottom left corner)
- 3. Unfold step 2
- 4. Fold the top left corner in the same way of step 2-3
- 5. Cut along the crease lines to get a triangle
- 6. Align the edges as shown in diagram to make crease lines
- 7. Fold in half

- 8. Bring the top corner down to the crease line you made from step 6
- 9. Squash fold the top flap
- 10. Result from squash fold
- 11. Flip over and bring the bottom flap to the left and make a vrease
- 12. Open the bottom flap and squash fold
- 13. Middle line to follow for the next step
- 14. Flip over and bring the sides to the middle
- 15. One module is complete, make 3 more

Flower core

- 1. Fold across both diagonals and unfold
- 2. Fold all the corners at around one-third
- 3. Flip over
- 4. Fold the edge as shown in diagram
- 5. Fold the corners to the centre
- 6. Fold the corners to the edge of the square in the middle
- 7. There are pockets to insert the flower petals
- 8. Flower core is complete
- 16. Apply glue to the bottom of the petal and insert it in the pocket of the flower core
- 17. Glue the rest of the petals in the same way.
- 18. Image from the back
- 19. Turn the flower over

Flower calyx

- 1-6. Fold in the same way as steps 1-6 to make a tulip
- 7. Fold the corner up
- 8. Open up the flaps
- 9. Flatten all the flaps
- 10. Flower calyx is complete
- 20. Use nippers to round the ends of the wire and apply glue, pass the wire through the centre of the flower calyx
- 21. Glue the calyx to the back of the flower
- 22. Image of the back of the flower
- 23. Apply glue to the folds of leaves and attach them to the wire type 3 *(instructions are on page 12 of Japanese booklet)* and glued together
- 24. Marguerite Daisy is complete

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BELLFLOWER

- Flower...Light Blue / 5 x 5 cm / 5 sheets
- Flower calyx...Dark Green / 4 x 4 cm / 1 sheet
- Leaf...Dark Green / 5 x 5 cm / 1 sheet (Instructions are on page 12 of Japanese booklet)

Flower

- 1. Fold in half diagonally
- 2. Fold the left edge along the bottom edge
- 3. Fold the other side in the same way
- 4. Unfold step 2
- 5. Bring the bottom left corner to the crease point on the right edge
- 6. Apply glue on the indicated area and bring back the top flap
- 7. One module is complete. Make 4 more
- 8. Glue them together
- 9. Spread the layers and glue together the first and the last modules
- 10. The front of the flower
- 11. The back of the flower

Flower calyx

- 1. Same as Marguerite Daisy's calyx
- 12. Use nippers to round the ends of the wire and apply glue, pass the wire through the centre of the flower calyx
- 13. Glue the calyx to the back of the flower
- 14. Flip over
- 15. Attach the leaf to the wire type 2 (*instructions are on page 12 of Japanese booklet*) and glued together
- 16. Bellflower is complete

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JAPANESE IRISES

- Flower...Purple 15 x 15 cm / 1 sheet
- Leaf...Dark Green / 15 x 15 cm / 1 sheet (Instructions are on page 12 of Japanese booklet)

Flower

- 1. Fold in half diagonally
- 2. Fold in half
- 3. Open the top layer at the central vertical crease line and bring the flap's corner to the top corner (squash fold)
- 4. (Squash fold is complete)
- 5. Fold the corner to the other side
- 6. Open the top layer at the central vertical crease line and bring the flap's corner to the top corner (squash fold)
- 7. Valley fold the middle flap inside
- 8. Bring the top left and right flaps to the middle line and unfold
- 9. Squash fold
- 10. Bring one flap to the left
- 11. Squash fold
- 12. Squash fold the remaining flaps
- 13. Fold top left and right edges to the middle line and unfold

- 14. Fold the bottom corner up to the top corner and unfold. Follow the existing creases from step 13 and open the top layer to bring the side edges to the middle
- 15. Fold up the flap
- 16. Repeat on the other side
- 17. Bring one flap from left to the right
- 18. Fold the bottom edges to the middle
- 19. Repeat step 18 on other 2 sides
- 20-22. Fold down each flaps
- 23. Lift up and curve the petals

24. Use nippers to round the end of the wire and apply glue, pass the wire through the centre of the flower

25. Attach a leaf to the wire - type 4 (instructions are on page 12 of Japanese booklet) and glued together

26. Japanese Iris is complete

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- Flower A...Red or Pink / 15 x 15 cm / 1 sheet
- Flower B...Orange or Light Pink / 11 x 11 cm / 1 sheet
- Flower C...Light Orange or Pale Pink / 6.5 x 6.5 cm / 1 sheet
- Leaves...Dark Green (or green) / 5 x 5 cm / 2 sheets (Instructions are on page 12 of Japanese booklet)

Flower

ROSE

- 1. Fold across both diagonals and unfold
- 2. Divide into 3 equal sections
- 3. It can be done by folding the paper as shown in the diagram
- 4. Make same creases from the other direction
- 5. Check all the creases and flip over
- 6. Fold the left and right edges to the existing crease lines
- 7. Fold the top and bottom edges to the existing crease lines
- 8. Fold the corners to the edges
- 9. Pull the corners out
- 10. Fold each corner to the opposite side
- 11. Fold the edges along the crease lines and unfold
- 12. Flip over
- 13. Fold up the edges
- 14. Pinch corners
- 15. Bring the corner to the bottom edge and crease
- 16. Unfold
- 17. Bring the shadowed corner to the bottom edge and tuck it in
- 18. Move to the next flap
- 19. Tuck in the corner same as last one
- 20. Fold the other corners in the same way
- 21. The look of a finished piece. Make 2 more same pieces in different sizes
- 22. Flower B...Open the flaps

- 23. Put the smallest flower (Flower C) inside the second largest flower (Flower B)
- 24. Fold the flaps back
- 25. Put the combined piece into the Largest flower (Flower A)
- 26. The complete flower
- 27. Attach leaves type 1 (*instructions are on page 12 of Japanese booklet*) to the flower and Rose is complete

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CANTERBURY BELL

- Flower...Light Pink / 10 x 10 cm / 3 sheets
- Flower calyx...Green / 2.5 x 2.5 cm / 3 sheets
- Leaves...Green / 5 x 5 cm / 4 sheets (Instructions are on page 12 of Japanese booklet)

Flower

- 1. Fold across both diagonals and unfold
- 2. Fold each corner to the centre point
- 3. Fold in half
- 4. Fold in half
- 5. Open the top layer at the central vertical crease line and bring the flap's corner to the top corner (squash fold)
- 6. (Squash fold is complete)
- 7. Flip over and fold the flap to the other side
- 8. Open the top layer at the central vertical crease line and bring the flap's corner to the top corner (squash fold)
- 9. Fold the corners to the other side to cross the middle line
- 10. Repeat behind
- 11. Crease nicely and unfold it to the shape of step 3
- 12. Open the top flap
- 13. Follow the existing creases to pinch the diamond shape
- 14. (Diagram of the part folded halfway)
- 15. Fold the corner to the centre
- 16. The paper is no longer flat from this step
- 17. Open the top layer
- 18. Same as in step 13
- 19. Bring the corner to the centre
- 20. Move to the next corner
- 21. Fold the remaining corners in the same way

Flower calyx

- 1. Same folds as the flower up to step 8
- 22. Glue the flower calyx to the flower
- 23. Curl the corners
- 24. Curl the remaining corners

- 25. One Canterbury Bells is complete. Make two more.
- 26. Use nippers to round the end of the wire and apply glue, pass the wire through the centre of the flower
- 27. Tape or glue the wires together
- 28. Attach the leaf type 4 *(instructions are on page 12 of Japanese booklet)* around the wire and glue it
- 29. Glue the rest of leaves in the same way and the Canterbury Bell is complete

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CARNATIONS

- Outer Flower...Red & Pink / 15 x 15 cm / 1 sheet each
- Inner Flower...Red & Pink / 13.5 x 13.5 cm / 1 sheet each
- Leaves...Dark Green / 7.5 7.5 cm / 2 sheets

Outer Flower

- 1. Fold in half diagonally
- 2. Fold in half
- 3. Open the top layer at the central vertical crease line and bring the flap's corner to the top corner (squash fold)
- 4. (Squash fold is complete)
- 5. Fold the corner to the other side
- 6. Open the top layer at the central vertical crease line and bring the flap's corner to the top corner (squash fold)
- 7. Bring the left flap over the centre line and squash fold
- 8. Flip over
- 9. Squash fold
- 10. Repeat step 7 on remaining flaps
- 11. Bring the top layer from left to the right and repeat behind
- 12. Fold down top corners
- 13. Repeat step 12 on remaining flaps
- 14. Fold the sides to the centre and unfold
- 15. Inside reverse fold
- 16. Repeat step 14-15 on all flaps
- 17. Leave outer flower for now and fold inner flower in the same way
- 18. Open outer and inner flowers and overlap the centre of the flowers. Follow the existing creases to bring the model back to step 17.
- 19. Use nippers to round the ends of the wire and apply glue, pass the wire through the centre of the flower
- 20. Fold in half vertically
- 21. Inside reverse fold
- 22. Open the flower
- 23. Adjust the shape
- 24. Separate the top and bottom layers to spread them out
- 25. The flower is complete
- 26. Attach leaves type 3 (instructions are on page 12 of Japanese booklet) and glued together

27. Carnation is complete

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Leaf 1

- 1. Fold in half diagonally
- 2. Fold one-third down
- 3. Fold left edge around half centimeters
- 4. Follow the edge to fold behind
- 5. Fold back to the front
- 6. Pleat fold
- 7. Crease nicely
- 8. Unfold to step 3
- 9. Fold down one flap with a little angle
- 10. Round the corners
- 11. Leaf 1 is complete

Leaf 2

- 1. Fold in half diagonally and unfold
- 2. Bring the top and left corner to the centre line and fold the beginning of the folding line should be on about one-third of the edge
- 3. Bring the top right and bottom right edges to the centre line
- 4. Fold the right corner halfway to the left
- 5. Fold top and bottom corners
- 6. Fold the corner to the right
- 7. Mountain fold in half horizontally
- 8. Fold down one layer with an angle
- 9. Leaf 2 is complete

Leaf 3

- 1. Fold in half diagonally
- 2. Fold the sides to the centre line
- 3. Fold the edges to the centre line
- 4. Fold the bottom edges to the centre line
- 5. Mountain fold in half vertically
- 6. Fold the top layer to the left with an angle
- 7. Leaf 3 is complete
