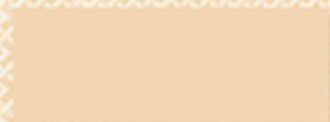
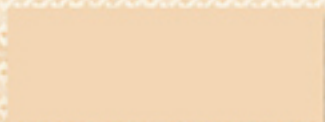


# BASIC Placemat #6



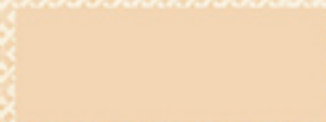
**A Repeating Stripe**  
2/3 yard



**B Top/Bottom Borders**  
1/2 yard



**C Binding**  
2/3 yard



**D 44/45" Backing**  
1-1/8 yards



# BASIC Placemat #6

*Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.*

*All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.*

## 1. Cut the following:

**Fabric A** - Cut (1) 18-1/2" strip, subcut  
(4) 9-1/2" x 18-1/2" multi-stripe border  
pieces

**Fabric B** - Cut (4) 3" strips, subcut  
(8) 3" x 18-1/2" strips

**Fabric C** - Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

**Fabric D** - Cut (2) 17" strips, subcut  
(4) 17" x 21" backing pieces

## 2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew **Fabric B** 3" x 18-1/2" strips to top and bottom of a **Fabric A** border piece. Make a total of 4 placemat tops (14-1/2" x 18-1/2" unfinished).

2. Layer and baste a placemat top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Trim batting and backing even. Attach binding (**Fabric C**). Repeat to make a total of 4 placemats and enjoy!!
