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Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, borders are cut longer than needed then trimmed to size.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel section to approximately 23-1/2" x 35-1/2"

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 3" x 43" and (2) 3" x 26" word-stripe borders

Fabric C - Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 38" and (2) 1-1/2" x 24" borders

Fabric D - Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

2. Piecing Order:

1. Refer to Quilt Layout for arrangement and placement of panel and borders.
2. Stitch **Fabric C** 1-1/2" x 24" borders to short sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/2" x 38" **Fabric C** borders to top and bottom of panel. Trim strip ends even.
3. Stitch **Fabric B** 3" x 26" borders to short sides of the quilt. Trim strip ends even. Add 3" x 43" **Fabric B** borders to top and bottom of quilt. Trim strip ends even.
4. The quilt measures approximately 30-1/2" x 42-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric E**) approximately 8" larger than the top.
5. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric D**) and enjoy!!
