## Manifold Routing Block

(Item #49-83)

## **FUNCTION:**


Routes up to 4 air or water inlet lines to 2 or 3 outlet lines each. Most often used to route main air and water and drive air in to various secondary valves, handpieces or syringe.

## INSTALLATION:

- 1. Make certain to attach the tubings exactly as shown in the illustration.
- Secure the tubing to the barbs using the provided sleeve clamps. If an inlet(s) is unused, the outlet(s) can be left open. If all outlets for a connected inlet are not used, the extra outlets should be plugged using a (#14-64) barb port plug.
- 3. Contact American Dental technical support if you have any questions concerning the installation of the routing block.

## NOTE:

The routing block does not provide any on/off or flow control functions. If simply splits multiple inlets inlets into even more outlets, which will ultimately feed to secondary valves that will perform the on/off and or flow control (e.g. handpiece control block).
