Description:

Super-thin, high accuracy, moisture-resistant dental articulating, and restoration fitting products. Offered in three formats. Loose film, Framed film, and Brush-on liquid.

Indications for Use:

For precisely locating occlusal prematurities in dental arches, and tight spots on the contacts or the intaglio of prosthetic restorations.

Precautions:

· Film Strips are for single patient use only. Discard after use.

Instructions for Use - Film

- 1. Dry natural tooth, restorative or prosthetic surfaces.
- 2. Hold the articulating film between the upper and lower arches in the area where occlusion is to be checked.
- 3. Have the patient tap their teeth together several times on the articulating film
- 4. Evaluate the markings on the tooth/restoration surfaces and adjust as needed
- 5. Repeat steps 1 through 4 until patients' occlusion is equilibrated.

Instructions for Use— Brush-On Liquid

- 1. Dispense liquid from dropper bottle into a single use disposable dispensing well or dappen dish
- 2. Utilizing a disposable single patient use tufted micro brush or bristle brush, coat the proximal or internal surface where adjustment may be needed
- 3. Allow liquid to fully dry on restoration surface
- 4. Seat restoration in the mouth with light pressure
- 5. Remove the restoration from the mouth and examine for areas where the blue AccuFilm IV coating rubbed away. These are the areas where corrective action would be necessary.
- Adjust restoration as needed.
- 7. Repeat steps 2 through 6 until proper restoration seating is achieved.
- 8. Use solvent liquid to remove residual AccuFilm IV from the restoration surface prior to commencing with cementation.

Helpful Hints:

- Use Articulating Forceps with loose film versions to stabilize and maintain shape, if desired.
- · For single-sided AccuFilm, the dull side is the marking side.

- For double-sided AccuFilm, both arches are marked simultaneously.
- When improved marking clarity is desired, applying a thin coat of petroleum jelly to the AccuFilm may promote clearer, more diagnostic marks.
- Tugging or pulling when the patient is in the closed position may result in the film tearing at the point of intercuspal contact.
- For unframed strips of AccuFilm I and II, a lengthwise fold down the center can help prevent curling. (When Articulating Forceps are not used.)




