

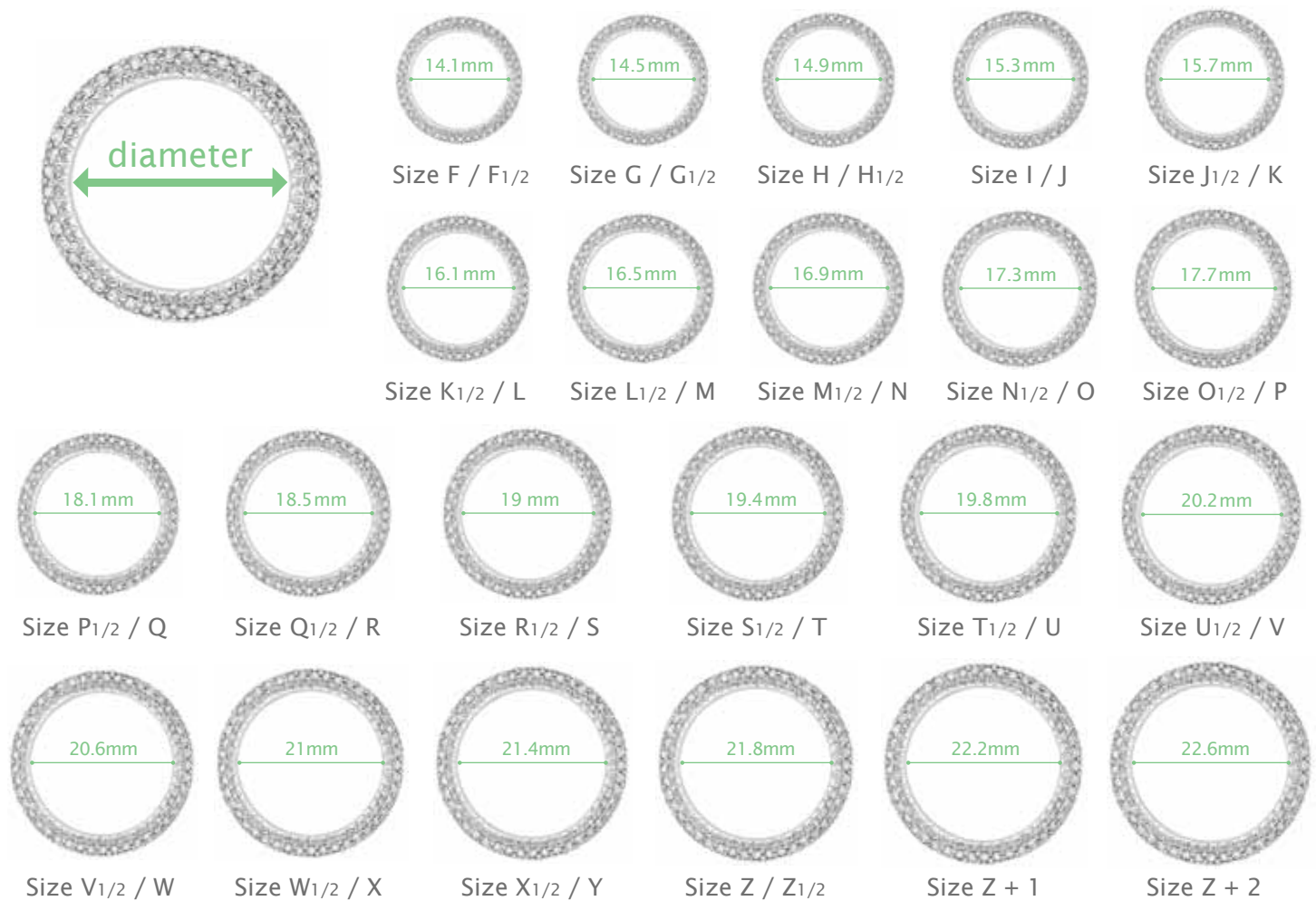
## How To Measure Your Ring Size

**1** First, find a ring that you own that fits perfectly. It should slide off with a slight tug, but you shouldn't have to pull at it to take it off.

**2** Place that ring over the circles until you find the perfect match.

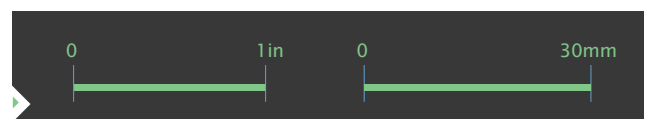
## Ring Sizes

The inside edge of the ring should match the inside edge of one of these circles. If your ring is between two sizes, order the larger size.



## Printing Scale of Ring Sizer

- Before printing, set the page scaling to "none" on your print dialog box.
- When printed this should be One Inch or 30 Millimeters
