FOOFA HAT



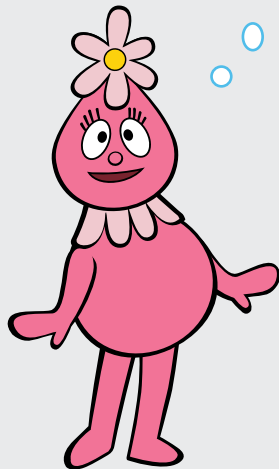
KNIT BEANIE

SKILL LEVEL

Intermediate

These sweet, brimmed
hats flower all year long.
Just like Foofa!



FINISHED SIZES

Child (Adult)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

18 (20)" circumference

MATERIALS

Madelinetosh Tosh Vintage (worsted weight; 100% superwash merino wool, 200yds/115g per hank): shown in 1 (1) skein of Foofchia

Madelinetosh Unicorn Tails (fingering weight; 100% superwash merino wool, 52yds/12g per hank): shown in 1 skein each of Petal Pink and Daisy Yellow

US Size 6 (4.0mm) 16" circular needle

US Size 7 (4.5mm) 16" circular needle

Set of four US Size 7 (4.5 mm) double pointed needles / DPNs

Tapestry needle

4 stitch markers, one in contrasting color

GAUGE

20 sts and 24 rows = 4" in St st using US Size 7 (4.5mm) needle
Adjust needle size if necessary to obtain correct gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

Instructions are given for the smallest size, with larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to both sizes.
Hat is worked from the bottom and up, in the round.

STITCH GUIDE

Stockinette Stitch (in the round)

K all sts.

2x2 Rib (flat and in the round)

All Rows/Rnds: *K2, p2; rep from * to end.

Garter Stitch (flat)

K all sts.



PATTERN



HAT

With Tosh Vintage in Foofchsia, CO 88 (100) sts using German Twisted cast on or Long Tail cast on. Join in the round and pm, taking care not to twist sts.

Work in 2x2 Rib until piece measures 4 (5)" from CO edge.

Change to larger circular needles and work in St st until piece measures 8.5 (9)" from CO edge, then begin Crown Shaping.

CROWN SHAPING

Child Size only

(Change to DPNs when necessary)

Rnd 1: *Knit 9 sts, k2tog, rep from * around. (80 sts rem)

Rnd 2 (and all even rnds): K around.

Rnd 3: *Knit 8 sts, k2tog, rep from * around. (72 sts rem)

Rnd 5: *Knit 7 sts, k2tog, rep from * around. (64 sts rem)

Rnd 7: *Knit 6 sts, k2tog, rep from * around. (56 sts rem)

Rnd 9: *Knit 5 sts, k2tog, rep from * around. (48 sts rem)

Rnd 11: *Knit 4 sts, k2tog, rep from * around. (40 sts rem)

Rnd 13: *Knit 3 sts, k2tog, rep from * around. (32 sts rem)

Rnd 15: *Knit 2 st, k2tog, rep from * around. (24 sts rem)

Rnd 17: *Knit 1 st, k2tog, rep from * around. (16 sts rem)

Rnd 19: *K2tog, rep from * around. (8 sts rem)

Break yarn and thread through remaining sts, pull tight and fasten inside hat.

Adult Size only

(Change to DPNs when necessary)

Rnd 1: *Knit 8 sts, k2tog, rep from * around. (90 sts rem)

Rnd 2 (and all even rnds): K around.

Rnd 3: *Knit 7 sts, k2tog, rep from * around. (80 sts rem)

Rnd 5: *Knit 6 sts, k2tog, rep from * around. (70 sts rem)

Rnd 7: *Knit 5 sts, k2tog, rep from * around. (60 sts rem)

Rnd 9: *Knit 4 sts, k2tog, rep from * around. (50 sts rem)

Rnd 11: *Knit 3 sts, k2tog, rep from * around. (40 sts rem)

Rnd 13: *Knit 2 sts, k2tog, rep from * around. (30 sts rem)

Rnd 15: *Knit 1 st, k2tog, rep from * around. (20 sts rem)

Rnd 16: K2tog around, rep from * around. (10 sts rem)

Break yarn and thread through remaining sts, pull tight and fasten inside hat.

FOOFA'S FLOWER

Center

Make 1

With larger needles and Daisy Yellow Unicorn Tail yarn held double, CO 3 sts using the Long Tail method.

Row 1: Kfb, kfb, k1. (5 sts)

Rows 2-5: K across. (5 sts)

Row 6: K2tog, k1, k2tog. (3 sts) BO.

Petals

Make 6

With larger needles and Petal Pink Unicorn Tail yarn held double, CO 2 sts using the Long Tail cast on method.

Row 1: Kfb, k1. (3 sts)

Row 2 (and all even rows): Knit across.

Row 3: K1, kfb, k1. (4 sts)

Row 5: Kfb, k2, k1. (5 sts)

Row 7: K3, kfb, k1. (6 sts)

Row 9: Kfb, k4, k1. (7 sts)

Row 11: K5, kfb, k1. (8 sts)

Row 13: Kfb, k6, k1. (9 sts)

Row 15: K7, kfb, k1. (10 sts)

Row 17: K across. (10 sts)

Row 19: K across. (10 sts)

Row 21: K1, k2tog, k4, k2tog, k1. (8 sts)

Row 23: K1, k2tog, k2, k2tog, k1. (6 sts)

Row 25: K1, k2tog twice, k1. (4 sts) BO.

KIDS CAN HELP!

Using coordinating Unicorn Tail yarn and tapestry needle, stitch Foofa's Flower petals to center of the flower, sewing pointy ends to center, and with rounded edges of petals facing out. Then lay hat flat and stitch flower to top of hat.

FINISHING

Secure and weave in any remaining ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

BO: bind off

CO: cast on

dec('d): decrease(d)

k: knit

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

kfb: knit 1 into front and back of a
stitch

pm: place marker

rem: remain

rnd(s): round(s)

st(s): stitch(es)

St st: stockinette stitch
