FABRIC RECOMMENDATIONS

The Clementine Pinafore & Dress can be made in a range of fabrics, depending on the version you're making. Version 1 is especially suited for medium weight denims, corduroys, canvases and twills. If you'd like to use a lighter weight denim or needlecord then this will work better for version 2. You'll also need a viscose, cotton or crepe for linings/facings (0.6m sleeveless, or 0.4m for sleeved), 25cm interfacing, a 30cm zip, a 2.5cm wide slider/buckle and seam tape interfacing.

For the Opal Coat, we recommend a medium to heavyweight fabric such as tweed, boucle, melton, jacquard and boiled wool. For the lining, opt for a viscose or crepe - something that will allow you to put your coat on with ease. If you can, opt for woven interfacing which will elevate your make.
