



Creating a Package Deal / Bundle

Follow these instructions to bundle products together. For example, you might wish to automatically sell a case along with a horn, or a mouthpiece pouch along with a mouthpiece. This will give you one barcode that will sell both at the same time.



Maintenance → Inventory → Package Deals



Hit "Add" (far bottom-right) to create a new package deal.


Type = Sales/Long Term Rental

Package SKU = the SKU and barcode you want on the combined package

Description = the title, i.e. Protec IPAC Case With Backpack Straps

DO NOT turn on Active-e. We will create the bundle on the website later.

Hit "Add" in the grey space on the right to add a product to your package deal.



Inv Type = Inventory

Model = hit F6 to search for the product's SKU

Description = once you find the correct product, this should auto-fill


Qty = the number of that product you wish to sell together in the package

Amount = this should auto-fill

Discount = tweak this amount until the whole package is for sale for the correct price

Let's say you want to sell a horn together with a case. You might put the horn as full price (\$0 discount) and the case as free (discount its entire price). Then check the Total box in the top-right to make sure the customer is being charged the correct price for the entire package.

Hit "Add" to add another product to the package deal.



When the package deal is complete, hit “Save”.

You might also want to check “Print Barcode Label” to get it to print a single barcode label.

No, there is no option to print multiple barcode labels. If you need to print another barcode label, you will need to make a change to the package, undo the change, check “Print Barcode Label” and “Save” again to get a second. Repeat for each barcode you need to print.

This package deal is not a normal product. You cannot access it through “Change Inventory”, for example.
