

# **3: COMPOSITION – INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS**

**Chemical Description:** The product is a mixture. Cosmetic product.

The full list of ingredients is printed on the packaging of the individual products in accordance to the provisions of Regulation 1223/2009 on cosmetic products. Carefully read the ingredients contained in the product indicated on the primary and secondary containers, under the word "contains".

For coloring products, if they are present, it is required the warning message: "Contains: phenylenediamines, phenylenediamines (toluenediamines), Resorcinol". For colors with ammonia it is also mandatory, the warning message "Contains: Ammonia".

For phenylenediamines (Ref. App. III, n. 8a of Regulation 1223/2009 on cosmetic products), if mixed in oxidative conditions, the maximum concentration applied to hair must not exceed 2.0% calculated as free base.

For phenylenediamines (toluenediamines), (Ref. App. III, n. 9a of Regulation 1223/2009 on cosmetic products), if mixed in oxidative conditions, the maximum concentration applied to hair must not exceed 2.0% calculated as free base (3.6% calculated as sulfate salt).

For Resorcinol (Ref. App. III, 22 of the Regulation 1223/2009 on cosmetic products), if mixed in oxidative conditions, the maximum concentration applied to hair must not exceed 1.25%.

### 4: FIRST AID MEASURES

## **5: FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES**

# **6: ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES**

### 7: HANDLING AND STORAGE

Precautions for safe handling

Advice on safe handling: Always store in the original containers. Tightly close the containers after use. Do not use in any way other than that provided in the instructions for use. Do not use metal containers, stirrers or tools. Do not mix with other oxidizing agents (such as hydrogen peroxide or bleaching products) with the exception of those prescribed. Use the dyeing mixture immediately. Any residual dyeing mixture can not be reused and must be disposed of immediately. Do not store the mixture in a closed container (it may swell and burst), in case you use a bottle for mixing the compound. Do not pierce nor burn the containers after use. Deliver only empty containers for recycling. Carefully follow the instructions for use. Keep out of the reach of children.

### Conditions for safe storage, including any incompatibilities

**Storage conditions** Store in a dry and well ventilated place (at room temperature). Do not store nor use the product near an open flame or a heat source (the product may



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deteriorate) or under direct sunlight. Do not store the product at temperatures below 5° C or above 40° C.

## 8: EXPOSURE CONTROL / INDIVIDUAL PROTECTION

### General advice

The work environment must be adequately ventilated, possibly with mechanical air circulation/aspiration (Art. 224 and Annex IV DLgs. 81/08 last amended by Legislative Decree 106/2009). The working place should be well ventilated. Good ventilation and good air exchange must be ensured. For professional use, wear protective clothing, goggles and gloves. Use work-tools thoroughly cleaned; Avoid nickel-plated instruments; Avoid wearing jewelry. Do not breathe vapors. Remove and wash contaminated clothing and gloves, including the inside, before re-use.



What is it:
