**If Swallowed** Rinse mouth with water. If swallowed, give a glass of water to drink. Do not induce vomiting. If vomiting occurs, give further water. Seek medical advice.

**In Eyes** Flush eyes with plenty of water for 15 minutes - also under the eyelids. Remove contact lenses if possible. If irritation persists, seek medical advice.

**Eyes** Vapours, liquids and mists may irritate the eyes.

**Skin** May be irritating with prolonged contact, especially when handling bulk quantities of liquid.
