## **Fabric Requirements**

21/4 yards Trio-C1274 White

1 yard Trio-C1274 Black (includes <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> yard for binding) <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> yard each:

Mix-C7200 Sun

Trio-C1265 White

Trio-C1272 Black

Trio-C1263 Black

<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> yard each:

Trio-C1269 Black

Trio-C1271 Yellow

Trio-C1273 Black

<sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> yard Trio-C1273 Yellow

<sup>1</sup>/<sub>3</sub> yard each:

Trio-C1266 Black

Ink-C8737 Yellow

Trio-C1270 White

Trio-C1264 Black

1/8 yard Trio-C1266 White

1/8 yard Trio-C1268 White

35/8 yards backing fabric of your choice

Other supplies 64" × 64" batting 2 yards fusible web, 20" wide

## **Preparation**

Some of the cut pieces (*E*, *F* and *G*) require fusible web under them for construction. When other (non-fusible) pieces are cut from the same fabric, cut those first, then follow the manufacturer's instructions to fuse the web to the fabric wrong side and cut the designated fusible pieces.

## **Cutting**

#### From Trio-C1274 White:

• Cut six 12<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × width-of-fabric (WOF) strips. Sub-cut sixteen 12<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares for block backgrounds.

#### From Mix-C7200 Sun:

Cut two 4" × WOF strips. Sub-cut eight Template D quarter circles and eight fusible Template F circles.

#### From Trio-C1274 Black:

- Cut six 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × WOF strips for binding.
- Cut five  $1^1/2^n \times WOF$  strips. Sew the strips together end to end. Sub-cut two  $1^1/2^n \times 48^1/2^n$  strips and two  $1^1/2^n \times 50^1/2^n$  strips for the inner border.
- From the remaining fabric, cut eight Template
   C arcs, six Template B wedges and eight fusible
   Template G circles.

## From Trio-C1269 Black, Trio-C1271 Yellow and Trio-C1273 Black:

Cut six Template B wedges and one Template E fusible flower.

## From Trio-C1265 White and Trio-C1272 Black:

• Cut six Template **B** wedges.

#### From Trio-C1273 Yellow:

- Cut six  $3" \times$  WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end. Sub-cut two  $3" \times 50^{1/2}"$  strips and two  $3" \times 55^{1/2}"$  strips for the outer border.
- Cut six Template **B** wedges.

# From each Trio-C1266 Black, Ink-C8737 Yellow, Trio-C1267 Black, Trio-C1264 Black and Trio-C1270 White:

Cut two Template B wedges and one Template E fusible flower.

#### From each Trio-C1266 White, and Trio-C1268 White:

• Cut two Template **B** wedges.

#### From Trio-C1263 Black:

• Cut eight Template **B** wedges.


#### **Block Construction**

All seam allowances are 1/4" and pieces are sewn right sides together.

## Fan Block

 Sort the Template B wedges into eight piles, distributing light and dark pieces equally. Alternating light and dark, sew eight wedges together to form an arc (figure 1).

2. Sew a C1274 Black **C** arc inside the pieced arc. To sew the curve, match the ends and the middle. Take a few stitches at time adjusting as needed to sew the curve (*figure 2*). Press the seam toward the **C** arc.




3. Sew a C7200 Sun **D** quarter circle to the inside of arc **C** using the same curve method as above to complete the fan motif (*figure 3*).

- 4. Press under the curved edge of the fan motif <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>". Apply fusible web to the back of a fan motif edges. Aligning the straight edges, place the fan in one corner of the 12<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" C1274 White square. Follow the manufacturer's instruction to fuse the fan edges in place.
- 5. Embellish the curved edge with a blanket or other decorative stitch to complete the block (*figure 4*).

6. Repeat steps 1-5 to make a total of eight fan blocks.

## Flower Block

7. Center and fuse a C1274 Black **G** circle to a C7200 Sun **F** circle (*figure 5*). Make a total of eight.



- 8. Fuse the layered C7200 Sun circle to an **E** flower center to complete the flower. Make a total of eight flowers.
- 9. Center and fuse a flower motif to each 12<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" C1274 White background square. Secure the fused pieces with a blanket or other decorative stitch to complete the block (*figure 6*).






## **Quilt Top Assembly**

10. Following Figure 7, sew together two fan blocks and two flower blocks as shown. Make two of each row.

Make 2 of each.

- 11. Following the quilt photo for placement and orientation, and matching adjacent seams, sew the four rows together in order.
- 12. Sew a  $1^{1}/2^{11} \times 48^{1}/2^{11}$  C1274 Black strip to each side of the quilt. Sew a  $1^{1}/2^{11} \times 50^{1}/2^{11}$  C1274 Black strip to the top and the other to the bottom of the quilt top.
- 13. Sew a 3"  $\times$  50<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" C1273 Yellow strip to each side of the quilt. Sew 3"  $\times$  55<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" C1273 Yellow strip to the top and the other to the bottom of the quilt top.

## **Finishing**

- 14. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing, and quilt as desired.
- 15. Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
- 16. Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.
