## **Fabric Requirements**

1 panel (²/₃ yard) Panel-CD1834 Midnight
 2 yards Soho-Black
 1¹/₃ yards Space-CD1839 Purple
 (includes ¹/₂ yard for binding)
 ¹/₄ yard Stripe-CD1840 Multi
 7/8 yard Butterfly-CD1836 Turquoise
 3¹/₂ yards backing fabric of choice
 61" × 79" batting

## **Cutting**

## From the Panel-CD1834 Midnight:

• Center the motif and trim the panel to  $22^{1}/2^{11} \times 40^{11}/2^{11}$ .

#### From Soho-Black:

- Cut two  $9^{1/2}$ " × width-of-fabric (WOF) strips. Sub-cut twenty  $2^{3/4}$ " ×  $9^{1/2}$ " strips (**A**).
- Cut two 5" × WOF strips. Sub-cut twenty  $2^{3}/4^{11} \times 5^{11}$  rectangles (**F**).
- Cut three  $2^3/4^{"} \times WOF$  strips. Sub-cut forty  $2^3/4^{"}$  squares (**E**).
- Cut four  $1^3/4^{\text{"}} \times \text{WOF}$  strips. Trim two strips to  $1^3/4^{\text{"}} \times 27^1/2^{\text{"}}$  for top/bottom border 2. Stitch a leftover piece to the end of each remaining strip and trim to  $1^3/4^{\text{"}} \times 43^{\text{"}}$  for side border 2.
- Cut six 4" × WOF strips. Stitch the strips together end to end. Sub-cut two 4" × 63<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" for top/bottom border 4 and two 4" × 52<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" for side border 4.

## From Space-CD1839 Purple:

- Cut one  $9^{1/2}$ " × WOF strip. Sub-cut twenty 2" ×  $9^{1/2}$ " strips (**B**).
- Cut two  $5" \times$  WOF strips. Sub-cut twenty  $2^3/4" \times 5"$  rectangles (1).
- Cut four  $1^3/4^{\text{"}} \times \text{WOF}$  strips. Trim two strips to  $1^3/4^{\text{"}} \times 40^1/2^{\text{"}}$  for side border 1. Trim the remaining two strips to  $1^3/4^{\text{"}} \times 25^{\text{"}}$  for top/bottom border 1.
- Cut seven 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × WOF binding strips.

#### From Stripe-CD1840 Multi:

Cut three 2" × WOF strip. Sub-cut ten 2" × 9<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips (C).

#### From Butterfly-CD1836 Turquoise:

- Cut two 5" × WOF strips. Sub-cut ten 5" squares (H).
- Cut six  $2^{3}/4^{"}$  × WOF strips. Sub-cut eighty  $2^{3}/4^{"}$  squares (**G**).

#### **Block Construction**

All seam allowances are <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" and pieces are sewn right sides together.

#### Star Block

- Draw a diagonal line on the back of each G square. Noting line direction, place a G square on the left corner of an (F) rectangle and stitch on the drawn line. Cut <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" beyond the sewn line and flip open the triangle.
- 2. In the same manner, place a G square on the right corner of the step 1 unit. Stitch on the drawn line. Cut  $^{1}/_{4}$ " from the sewn line and flip open the triangle to complete the  $2^{3}/_{4}$ "  $\times$  5" flying-geese unit (*figure 1*). Make a total of twenty gray flying-geese units.







**Gray Flying-geese unit** Make 20.

3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 using the remaining **G** squares and **I** rectangles (*figure 2*). Make a total of twenty purple flying-geese units.




Purple Flying-geese unit Make 20.



4. Stitch an **E** square to each side of a gray flying-geese unit creating a  $2^3/4^{\circ} \times 9^1/2^{\circ}$  row. Press seams toward the **E** squares (*figure 3*). Make a total of sixteen gray rows.

5. Repeat step 4 using two **E** squares and a purple flying-geese unit (*figure 4*). Make a total of four purple rows.

6. Noting the orientation, stitch a purple flying-geese unit to each side of an **H** square creating 5" × 9<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" center row (*figure 5*). Press seams toward the **H** square. Make a total of six purple center rows.



7. Repeat step 6 using one gray flying-geese unit, one **H** square and a purple flying-geese unit (*figure 6*). Make a total of four mixed center rows.


8. Following Figure 7, lay out one gray row on the top and bottom of a purple center row. Matching adjacent seams, stitch the rows together in order completing the block. Make a total of six Star blocks.

9. Following Figure 8, lay out one gray row, one mixed center row and one purple row. Matching adjacent seams, stitch the rows together in order completing the block. Make a total of four Star Corner blocks.


**Star Corner Block** Make 4.

## Bar Block

10. Lay out two **A** strips, two **B** strips, and one **C** strip as shown in Figure 9. Stitch together in order completing the bar block. Make a total of ten Bar blocks.


**Bar Block** Make 10.

# **Quilt Top Assembly**

Follow the Quilt Assembly Diagram to assemble the quilt.

- 11. Stitch one side border 1 to each side of the center panel, and one top/bottom border 1 strip to the top and the other to the bottom of the panel. In the same manner, add the side border 2 and top/bottom border 2.
- 12. Following Figure 10, lay out three Bar blocks alternately with two Star blocks. Matching adjacent seams, stitch the blocks together to create side border 3. Make two. Stitch one side border 3 to each side of the quilt center.



**Side Border 3** Make 2.

13. Following Figure 11, lay out two Star Corner blocks and one Star block alternately with two bar blocks. Matching adjacent seams, stitch the blocks together to create a top/bottom border 3. Make two. Stitch one to the top and the other to the bottom of the quilt center.




**Top/Bottom Border 3**Make 2.

14. Stitch one side border 4 to each side of the quilt center, and one top/bottom border 4 to the top and the other to the bottom of the quilt center.

## **Finishing**

- 15. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing, and quilt as desired.
- 16. Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
- 17. Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.
