## Befare Yau Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a $1 / 4$ in ( 6.35 mm ) seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof = width of fabric. Print Appliqué Templates at $100 \%$ scale.

## Cutting

Use a rotary cutter and ruler to cut the size and number of squares and rectangles from each fabric listed below. Set aside the remaining fabric for making the appliqués.

## Sewing

1. Use the templates provided to trace the number of appliqué shapes on the paper side of fusible web as shown in Diagram A. Leave $1 / 4 \mathrm{in}(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ between shapes and cut out $1 / 8$ in $(3.18 \mathrm{~mm})$ outside the traced line.

2. Refer to Diagram B to place the fusible web appliqué pieces on the wrong side of each fabric, adhesive side down. Fuse according to the manufacturer's directions. Cut out on the traced lines. Remove paper backing.

3. Refer to Diagram $C$ to position the appliqué pieces right side up on the right side of the Circle Dots square ( $261 / 2$ in $\times 26 \frac{1}{2}$ in $/ 67.31 \mathrm{~cm} \times 67.31 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Center the triangle tree shapes on top of each other as shown. Note: Check that appliqué pieces are at least $3 / 4$ in ( 19.1 mm ) away from edges and check orientation of designs. Fuse to the right side of the fabric according to the manufacturer's directions. Use a coordinating thread and small buttonhole or zig-zag stitch to secure and finish the edges. The Center Appliqué Block should measure $26 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 26 \frac{1 ⁄ 2}{2}$ in ( $67.31 \mathrm{~cm} \times 67.31 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

4. Place a Fox square ( $41 / 2$ in $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ in / $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on each side of a Scenic rectangle ( $41 / 2$ in $\times 26 \frac{1}{2}$ in $/ 11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 67.31 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram D. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Scenic Top Border ( $41 / 2$ in $\times 341 / 2$ in / $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 87.63 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Repeat to make the Scenic Bottom Border. Note: Check orientation of designs.

5. Place a Fox square ( $41 / 2$ in $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ in / $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on each side of a Plaid Patch Fussy Cut rectangle ( $41 / 2$ in $\times 401 / 2$ in $/ 11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram E. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Plaid Patch Top Border ( $41 / 2$ in $\times 481 / 2$ in $/ 11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 123.19 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Note: Check orientation of designs.

6. Place a Fox square ( $41 / 2$ in $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ in / $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on each side of a Plaid Patch Fussy Cut rectangle ( $41 / 2$ in $\times 401 / 2$ in $/ 11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram F. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Plaid Patch Bottom Border ( $41 / 2$ in $\times 48 \frac{1}{2}$ in $/ 11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 123.19 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Note: Check orientation of designs.

7. Refer to Diagram G to place the Borders around the Center Appliqué Block ( $261 / 2 \mathrm{in} \times 261 / 2 \mathrm{in} / 67.31 \mathrm{~cm} \times 67.31 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Sew each Border RST in the order listed. Pin matching center, seams and ends. Press seams as shown. Measure at each step to ensure the next border will fit. If one border is a little larger than the border it is being sewn to, pin well to ease the fullness and place the fullness on the bottom while sewing. Finished Quilt Top should measure $481 / 2 \mathrm{in} \times 481 / 2$ in ( $123.19 \mathrm{~cm} \times 123.19 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

## Scenic Border

Sides: 2 - Scenic rectangles ( $41 / 2$ in x $261 / 2$ in / $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 67.31 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Top and Bottom: Scenic Top and Bottom Borders ( $41 / 2$ in $\times 341 / 2$ in $/ 11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 87.63 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Quilt Top - $341 / 2$ in $\times 341 / 2$ in ( $87.63 \mathrm{~cm} \times 87.63 \mathrm{~cm}$ )

## Circle Dots Border

Top and Bottom: 2 - Circle Dots strips ( 2 in $\times 341 / 2$ in $/ 5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 87.63 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Sides: 2 - Circle Dots strips ( 2 in x $371 / 2 \mathrm{in} / 5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 95.25 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Quilt Top - $371 / 2$ in x $371 / 2$ in ( $95.25 \mathrm{~cm} \times 95.25 \mathrm{~cm}$ )

## Plaid Border

Top and Bottom: 2 - Plaid strips ( 2 in $\times 371 / 2$ in $/ 5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 95.25 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Sides: 2 - Plaid strips ( 2 in $\times 401 / 2$ in $/ 5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Quilt Top - 40 ½ in x $401 / 2$ in ( $102.87 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ )

## Plaid Patch Border

Sides: 2 - Plaid Patch Fussy Cut rectangles ( $41 / 2$ in x $401 / 2 \mathrm{in} / 11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Top and Bottom: Plaid Patch Top and Bottom Borders ( $41 / 2 \mathrm{in} \times 481 / 2 \mathrm{in} / 11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 123.19 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Dia. G


## Finishing

8. Remove the selvages from the Fox Backing fabric.

Note: Check orientation of designs. Cut one piece $401 / 4$ in $\times 56$ in ( $102.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times 142.24 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) and two pieces $16 \frac{1}{4}$ in $\times 28 \frac{1}{4}$ in ( $41.28 \mathrm{~cm} \times 71.76 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Pin RST and sew the two smaller pieces on the short edges; press. Pin the two sections RST and sew along the long edges as shown in Diagram H. Press the seam open or to one side. The Backing should measure 56 in $\times 56$ in ( $142.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times 142.24 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
9. Press finished Quilt Top and Backing. Tape the Backing, wrong side up, to a firm surface. Layer Batting and Quilt Top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
10. Once quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and Batting even with the Quilt Top.

11. Binding - Follow Diagram I to make the Plaid Binding. Remove selvages and sew the short ends of the five $21 / 2$ in ( 6.35 cm ) $x$ wof strips RST end to end at a $45^{\circ}$ angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end $1 / 4$ in ( 6.35 mm ) to the wrong side. Fold in half lengthwise with wrong sides together; press. Leaving a 2 in ( 5.08 cm ) tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Quilt Top and sew, mitering the corners. Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold Binding over to back and hand stitch.


## Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. Tip: Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
