3/4 yard	Folio Basics - True Red (B)	7755-82*
1 1/8 yards	Sun and Clouds - Blue (C)	614-11
5/8 yard	Quarter Inch Stripe - Multi (D)	616-186
1/2 yard	Tossed Bees - Multi (E)	617-49
1/2 yard	Check - Black/White (F)	621-99
3/8 yard	Tossed Animals - Multi (G)	615-186
1/4 yard	Tossed Boats - Royal (H)	619-77
1/4 yard	Tossed Octopus - Royal (I)	620-77
1/4 yard	Moons and Clouds - Royal (J)	613-77
1/2 yard	Folio Basics - White on White (K)	7755-01W
1 2/3 yards	Hot Air Balloon, Rocket, Planes - Blue (L)	612-11

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the 24 Inch Alphabet Panel - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 20 1/2" x 34 3/4" rectangle, centered on the panel

From the Folio Basics - True Red (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 34 3/4" WOF strips.
- (2) 2 1/8" x 23 1/2" WOF strips.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Sun and Clouds - Blue (C), cut:

- (2) 4 1/2" x 37" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 3 1/2" x 30 1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Quarter Inch Stripe - Multi (D), cut:

- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 43" strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 52 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x 42 1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 1 1/4" x 32 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Tossed Bees - Multi (E), cut:

- (3) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Check - Black/White (F), cut:

- (5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Tossed Animals - Multi (G), cut:

- (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Tossed Boats - Royal (H), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.

From the Tossed Octopus - Royal (I), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Moons and Clouds - Royal (J), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Folio Basics - White on White (K), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 54 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 45 1/2" strips.

From the Hot Air Balloon, Rocket, Planes - Blue (L), cut:

- (2) 4 1/2" x 57 1/2" LOF strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 4 1/2" x 53 1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Tossed Letters - Royal (Backing), cut:

- (2) 61" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 61" x 73" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 34 3/4" Fabric B strip to each side of the 20 1/2" x 34 3/4" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2 1/8" x 23 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 22 1/2" x 37"**.

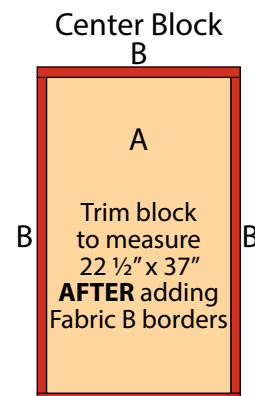

2. Place (1) 2 ½” Fabric F square on the top left corner of (1) 4 ½” Fabric E square, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼” away from the sewn seam (Fig. 3).

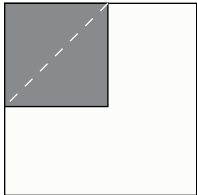

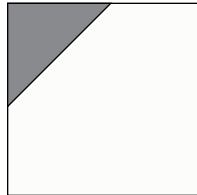

3. Follow Figure 4 for the seam direction to add a 2 ½” Fabric F square to each of the remaining corners of the 4 ½” Fabric E square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 5).

4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (20) Block One squares total.

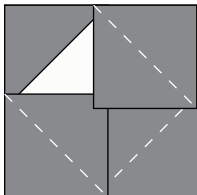

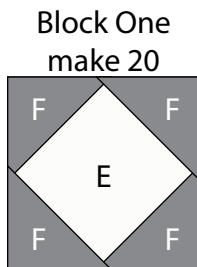

5. Refer to Figure 6 and sew together (6) Block One squares, (3) 4 ½” Fabric G squares and (2) 4 ½” Fabric J squares to make (1) Side Border. Repeat to make a second Side Border.

6. Refer to Figure 7 and sew together (2) 4 ½” Fabric I squares, (4) Block One squares, (2) 4 ½” Fabric G squares and (1) 4 ½” x 8 ½” Fabric H strip to make the Top Border. Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

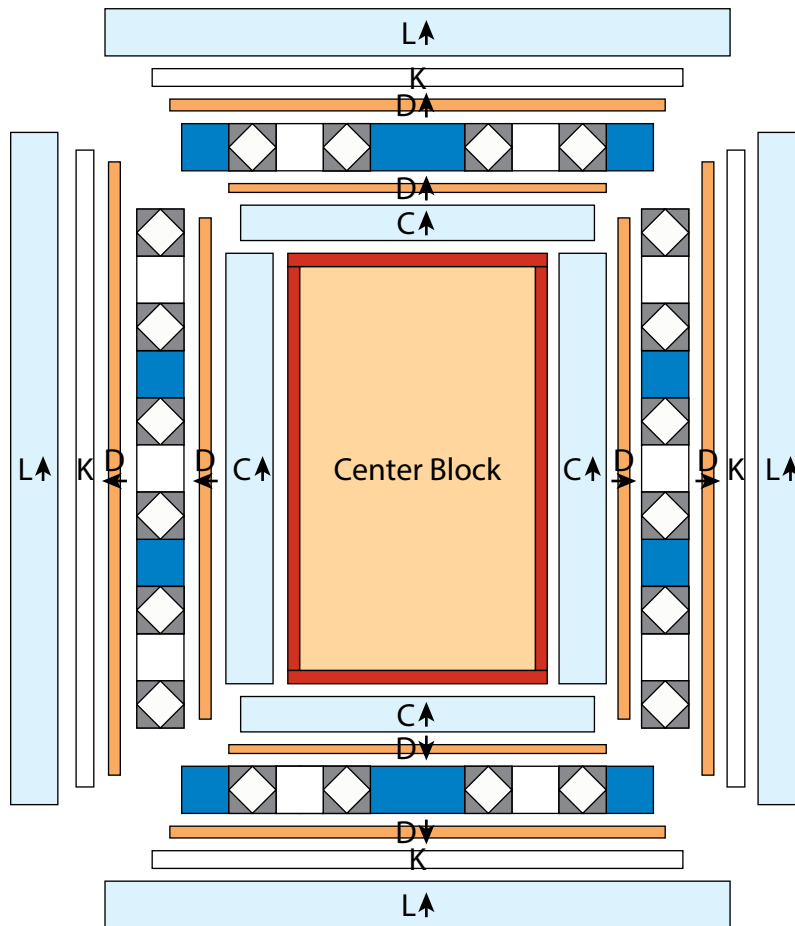

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

7. Sew (1) 4 ½” x 37” Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block.
8. Sew (1) 3 ½” x 30 ½” Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
9. Sew (1) 1 ½” x 43” Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ¼” x 32 ½” Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Top and Bottom Borders to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) 1 ½” x 52 ½” Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½” x 42 ½” Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
12. Sew (1) 2” x 54 ½” Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2” x 45 ½” Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
13. Sew (1) 4 ½” x 57 ½” Fabric L strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4 ½” x 53 ½” Fabric L strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
14. Layer and quilt as desired.
15. Sew the (6) 2 ½” x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
16. Bind as desired.
