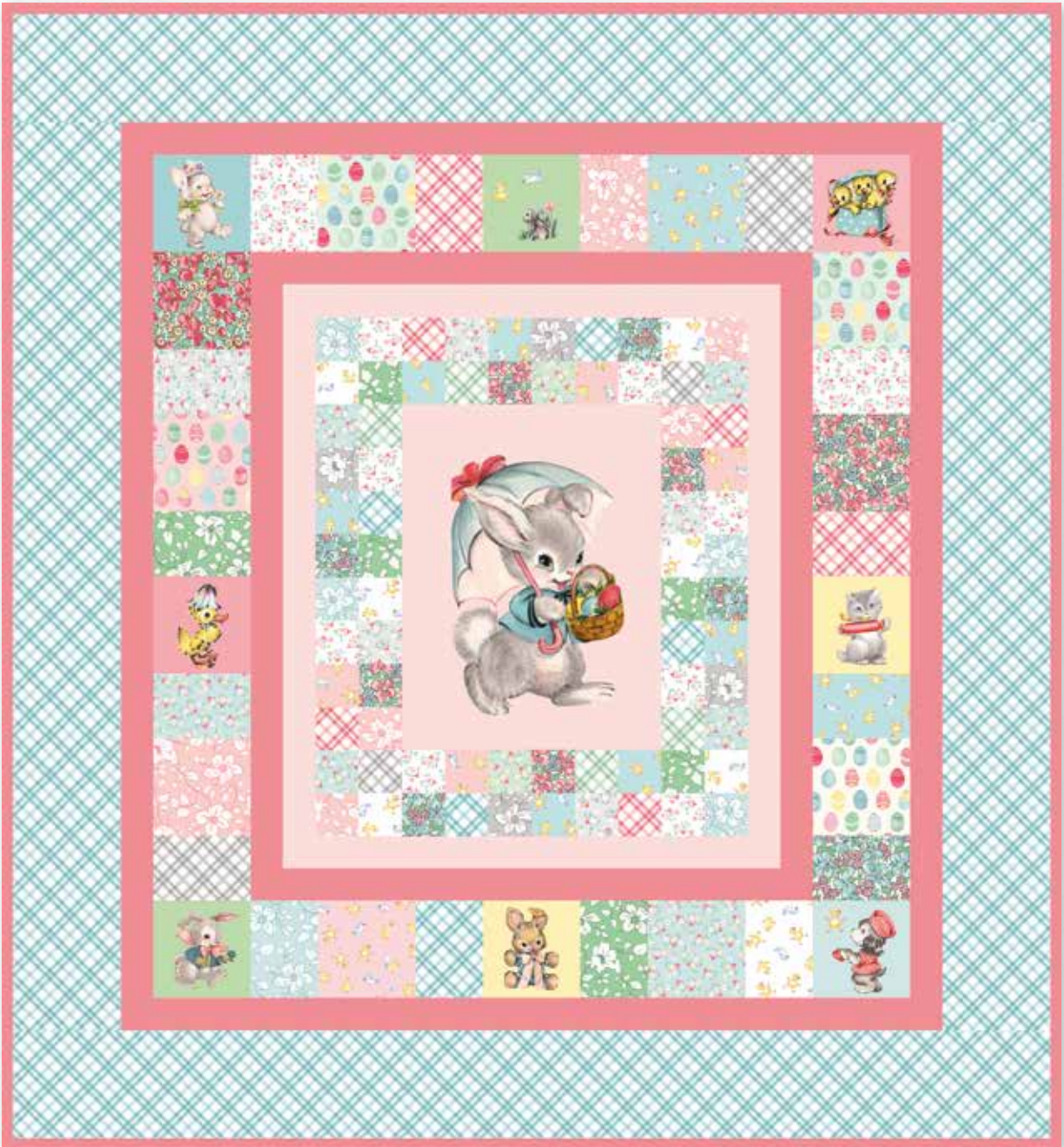

EASTER PARADE

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 48" x 52"

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Easter Parade 5" Stacker (5-11570-42)

1 Easter Parade Panel (P11577)

1 Yard Aqua Check (C11576)

1 Yard Sugar Pink Confetti Cotton Solid (C120)*

*Includes Binding

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting.

WOF- width of fabric.

Easter Parade 5" Stacker

Select 8- 5" squares and trim to measure $3\frac{5}{8}$ " x 5".

Select 8- 5" squares and trim to measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5".

The rest will remain 5" square.

Panel

Fussy cut one center panel $23\frac{1}{2}$ " x $27\frac{1}{2}$ ", centered over the large bunny motif.

Fussy cut eight 5" x 5" squares, centered over the animal motif blocks on the top and bottom of panel.

Aqua Check

Cut 6 strips $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 4.

Sugar Pink Solid

Cut 4 strips 2" x WOF for Border 1.

Cut 4 strips 2" x WOF for Border 3.

Cut 7 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for binding.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the quilt photo for the placement of prints.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew side borders first. Press seams towards the borders.

Border 1

Side borders should be $27\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $26\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Border 2

Sew 4- $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5" rectangles, 3- 5" squares and 1 fussy cut 5" square together (5 " x $30\frac{1}{2}$ "). Press the seams in one direction. Repeat to make 2 side borders.

Sew 4- $3\frac{5}{8}$ " x 5" rectangles, 2- 5" squares and 3 fussy cut 5" squares together (5 " x $35\frac{1}{2}$ "). Press the seams in one direction. Repeat to make the bottom border.

Border 3

Side borders should be $39\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $38\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Border 4

Side borders should be $42\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $48\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with the Sugar Pink solid strips. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
